Congratulations to the town of Georgetown and the Ontario Water Resources Commission on the opening of the new sewage treatment plant. This is a big step towards clearing the pollution in the Credit River, however, unfortunately the Health Dept states that there are still other sources of pollution emptying into the Black Creek and the West Branch which joins the Credit at the upper end of Norval, and so the "Unit for Swimming" signs must stay up on the Credit through the village until these sources are eliminated.

The children of Norval know the old time nursery rhyme on it too well --

"Mother, may I go in to swim?"

"Yes, my darling daughter,

Hang your clothes on a hickory limb,

But don't go near the water!"

The Health Dept. states that the river above the West Branch is safe for swimming as regards pollution, and the children have been hiking up to an old swimming hole on Col. A. Noble's property for their daily dip, but this has its drawbacks, one being that it is out of the village and un-supervised, another, as several can testify, is the poison ivy that flourishes nearby, not to mention the fact that they are trespassing on private property.

Swimming is a dangerous sport under the best of conditions. We hope that the other sources of pollution are soon cleared so that the children may swim closer to home and to help in the case of an emergency.
