Contractor Equipment Is Damaged In Fire

Fire Chief Bob Bonfield estimated damage at \$4,000 as the result of a blaze which levelled a contractor's shack on the building site of the Prestite Division of Canadian Marietta's new plant early Friday morning.

The blaze, which lit up the sky for miles, was discovered by Police Constables Yd Scott and Mike Christopher while patrolling the area. By the time firemen arrived the shack and its contents were beyond saving. Hoses were trained on two other sheds housing the office of the Didd Construction Company and the Constable's Company which were threatened.

Damaged were a sand compressor, a cement mixer, 100 bags of lime, 100 bags of cement and two weigh scales. Most of the items belonged to the contractor. During the fire a couple of propane gas tanks exploded sending fiery clouds high into the darkness. A strong wind eliminated any chance of saving part of the shack. Tarpsulins around the building itself were also touched off by the flames.

An inaugural service for the new United Church Women's Association was conducted by the Rev. John Hill at the morning service on Sunday at the Hornby United Church.

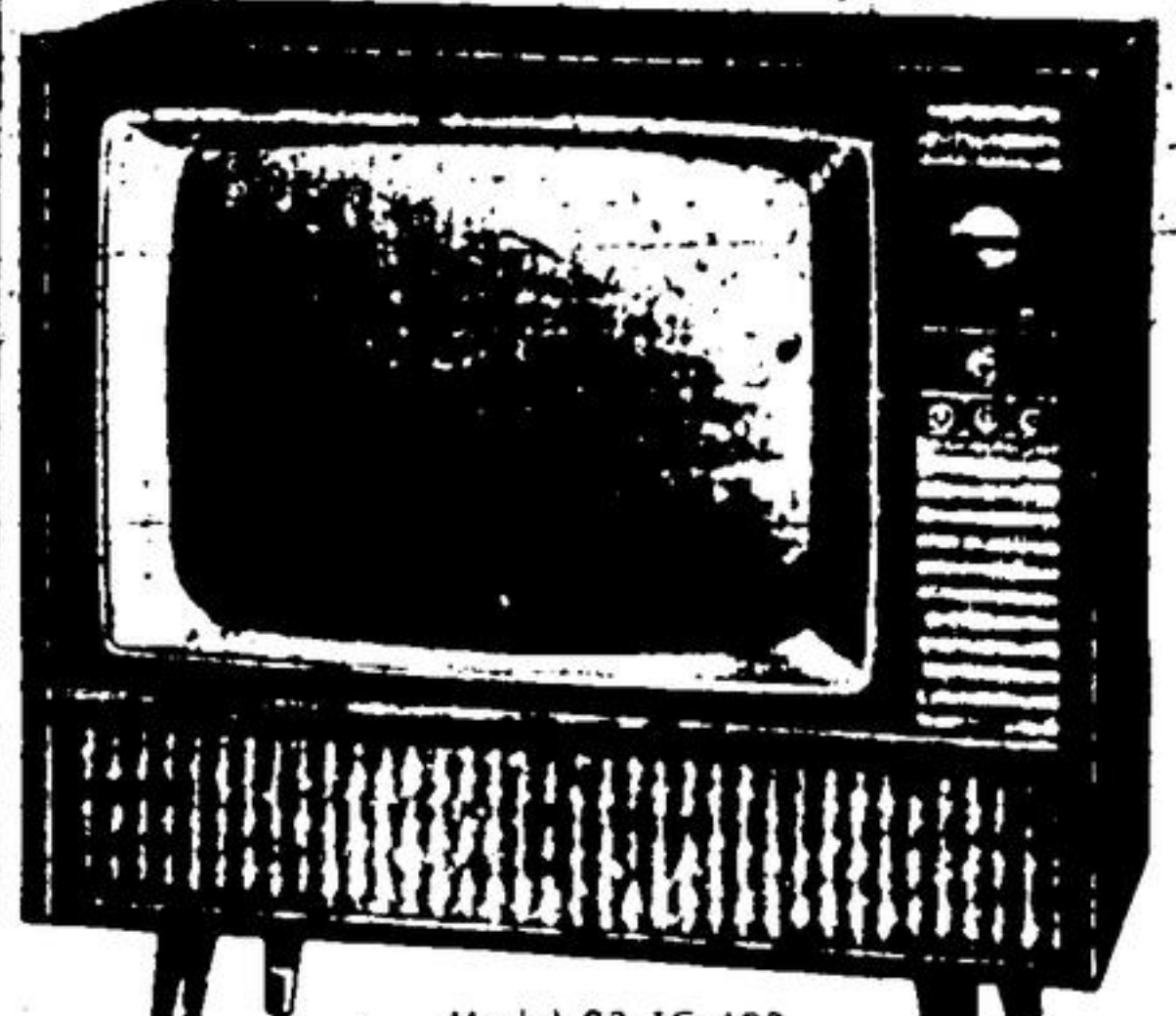
