Guelph Comes Out of Hiding Rapped 9-4 by Raiders Here

A bearded defenseman, the return of two Raiders, one in Guelph colours, and a final period slug fest livened a Raiders 9-4 win over the C.O.H.L.'s mystery team, Guelph, here Friday night.

The game was a four pointer and boosted Georgetown back into the cramped quarters near the league ceiling. The race has turned into a three team affair with Bradford, Oakville and Georgetown bobbing up and down like pistons.

Guelph occupies 6th place between Milton and Port Credit. Raiders upped their prospects both teams registered three, for a league crown in this game Favero and McPhee set up when they iced a potent third Restelli's first at 5:22. Bolton through the return of Bud Var-ey who Coach Elmer Lee link- ed with Dave Irons and Wayne Sandwiched between the last Thompson. Up until then the third herd had been a far cry from the goal potential offered by the Beaumont, Inglis, Rich- ards trio or the Geland, Dunn Demerise line.

Bud Var-ey was the only Raider, the fans in the stands were waving after a long ab- sence. Wearing No. 16 for the Guelph club was ex-Raider Lugo Bolep who obviously had lost very little speed and picked up a lot of hockey knowhow since he shed local colours. Raiders chose to play it slack and still finished the first per- iod with a 4-1 gap.

Joe Auger banged in the first one, unassisted, at 2:42. Gerry Inglis took Mike Geland's pass and picked the short side as the home club made it 2-0. Guelph found the range with Daniels on the scoring end of a three cornered play start- ed by B. Evans and D. Evans, at 11:05.

Seconds later Junior Beau- mont regained the two goal lead for Georgetown from Blake Inglis and Doug Richardson, and then on the Raiders' power play he found in Milton this Satur- day and Georgetown delegates of the Guelph edge and banjo eyes punched it home.
