Mackenzie To Build Kennedy Addition

A local firm, J. B. Mackenzie and Son, has been awarded the contract to build an addition to Kennedy Public School. The company was the lowest of 7 tenders opened and reviewed at a meeting of the Public School Board last Thursday and will start work on the new rooms immediately so that they will be ready for occupancy in September.

The addition includes six regular classrooms, a kindergarten, extra washrooms, and storage space. The Mackenzie bid was \$123,266.00. Monday the board asked council to raise \$142,000 to cover the general contract, furniture, architects fees, etc.
