**Call Road Work Tenders
Estimate \$143,000**

Will Seal, Chip Many Town Roads
Road work estimated to cost \$143,000 was endorsed Monday by council and advertising for tenders ordered. Road chairman Fred Harrison said that the projected work would be \$13,000 over the road budget, but this would be compensated in an anticipated extra \$13,000 in government grants.

Final Surfacing
Seal and chip on a number of roads, a Delrex Blvd. storm sewer, a new Ontario Street bridge and final surfacing of a portion of Main Street are included in the plans.

"This certainly won't cover all the town roads and I hope no one will be saying 'No fair' for we can only spend our budget," said Cr. Harrison. "I would say that 99% of the old part of town needs road work and 100% of the newer part."

A certain amount of permanent construction is included in plans, he pointed out, continuing a council policy of several years.

Concrete box culverts are planned at one point on south Main Street. And a new road base and surface treatment, with curbs, gutters and catch basins and storm sewers at a bad spot at Valleyview, Charles and Market area.
