Proposed By-law to authorize the widening and altering of Ontario Street from a point on its south side, measured 295.60 feet from Main Street for a distance of 2,410.75 feet, and from a point on its north side measured 532.73 feet from Main Street for a distance of 2,410.75 feet.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Georgetown proposes on Monday, the 15th day of October, 1962, at the hour of eight (8) o'clock in the afternoon or as soon thereafter as it may deem advisable, to authorize the altering and widening of:

1. Part of the northerly side of Ontario Street, commencing 532.73 feet from Main Street for a distance of approximately 2,410.75 feet, having a perpendicular width of 8.25 feet and being part of Lots 10 and 20, Concession 9, Esplanade, now in the Town of Georgetown.
2. That part of the southerly side of Ontario Street, commencing 295.60 feet from Main Street for a distance of approximately 2,500.75 feet, having a perpendicular width of 8.25 feet, and being part of the east half of Lot 20, Concession 9, Esplanade, now in the Town of Georgetown, according to Plan No. 50 for the Town of Georgetown.

The Council will hear in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, any persons who claim that his land will be prejudicially affected by the said By-law, and who applies to be heard.

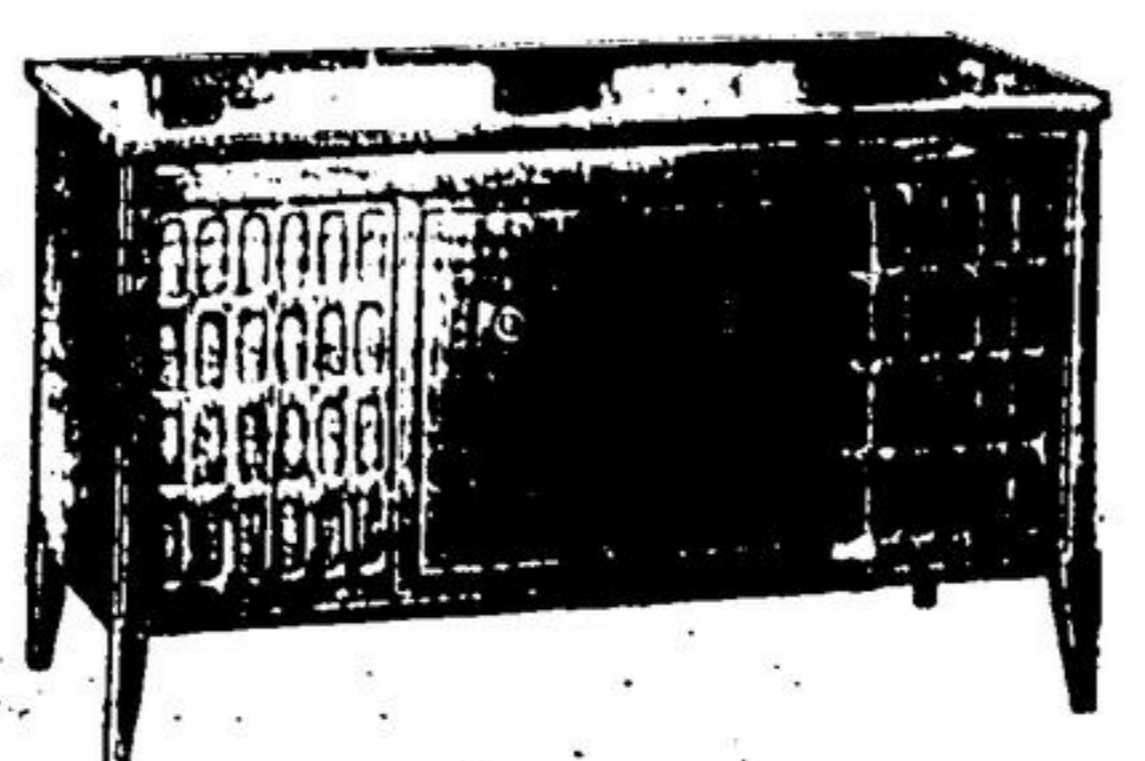
