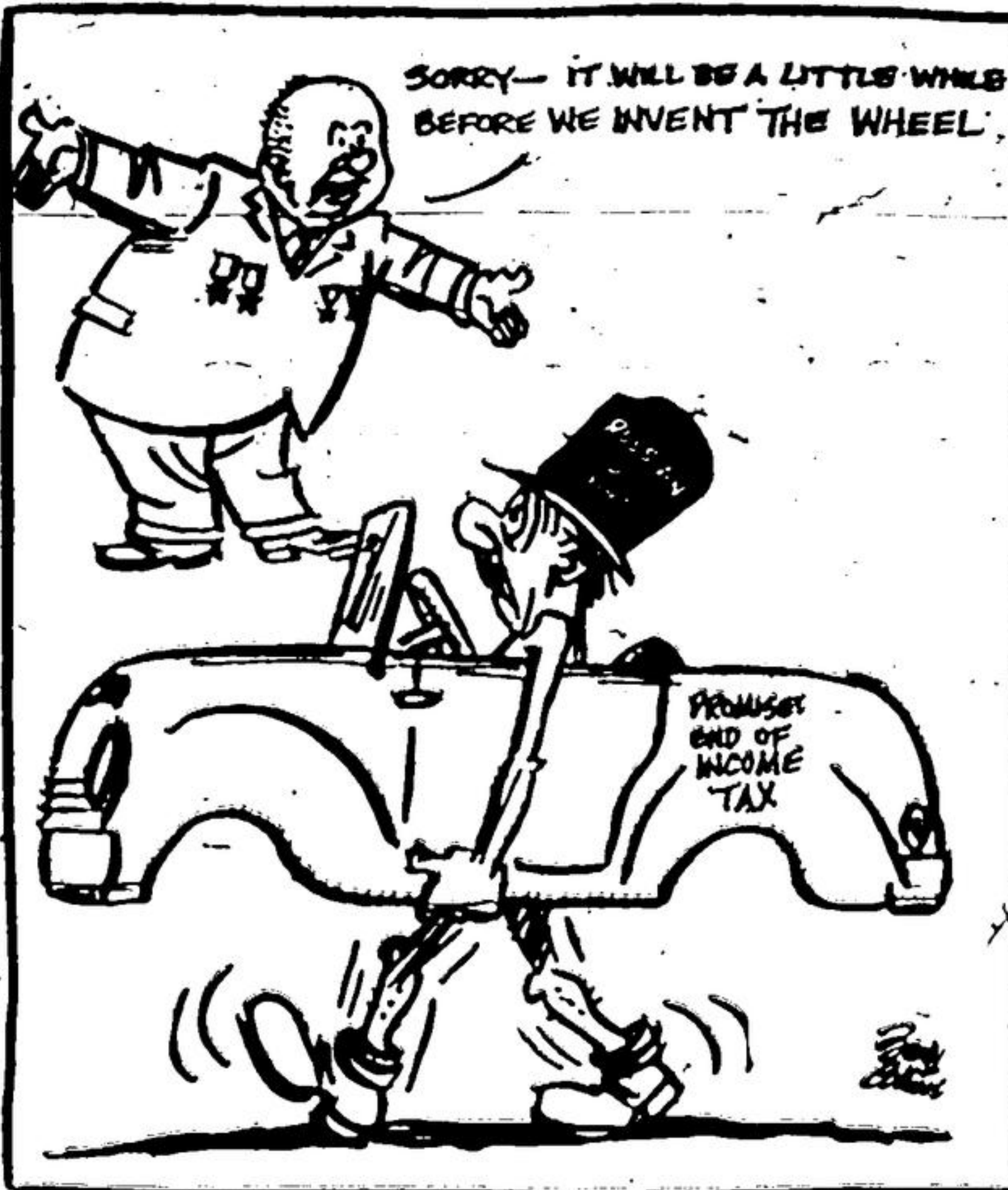
School Increase Continues
