

Choose Doctor and Administrator For Milton School for the Deaf

Appointments to the staff of the Ontario School for the Deaf, Milton, have taken place during the past few days, reports superintendent D. E. Kennedy.

Dr. Carl Hiltz, Milton, has been appointed School Doctor on a part-time basis. He will be in general charge of the school hospital, staffed by a nurse supervisor, a registered nurse and a houseparent, with additional nursing staff being engaged when required.

Advisory Capacity meantime he is making visits to the school every few days and is assisting in the organization of the school's business office. Mr. Hiltz has been with the Department of Education for the past 19 years, for some responsibilities at the school hospital and will have jurisdiction over the health practices and living conditions of the children.

Principal Explains Aims of Education

A crowd of 120 overflowed the George Kennedy Home & School Association, meeting last Wednesday night to hear Principal Hazen Allen outline his conception of the main aims of education.

He felt the first and basic one to be the provision of the necessary fundamental academic skills to meet their daily needs, secondly, the equipping of the child socially for his environment, and thirdly, helping the child to understand that environment. Reverting to local issues, he explained the method of teaching a standard lesson in response to requests he explained the method of reading instruction and emphasized that phonics is being taught in the modern day school. In addition he outlined the major steps in mathematics from grade to grade. In conclusion he gave a brief rundown of school regulations, which, he explained, are the same in all Georgetown schools. 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Study Water Level Conservation Area

A study of the high water level of Silver Creek, as proper boundaries for a conservation area can be set, is being planned by council. Council was told Monday by the Planning Board that the water level study should be made and consideration given to the town taking a long term option on the land for the value of the annual taxes. Council's property committee will discuss costs of the survey before deciding on action.

Ask Town Service Vulcan Watermains

Five years ago, a waterline to service the suburban Vulcan Home development on the 7th line was installed with Vulcan paying all costs and the town agreeing to sell water to residents. Monday, a letter from solicitor John Ode acting for the Vulcan firm, asked the town to take over maintenance of the watermains. Council seemed agreeable and turned it over to the water committee for study. Residents of the subdivision pay double water rates to the town, as do all out-of-town consumers.
