

Anglican Rector Has Canadian Flag Idea

A flag, it has been well said, is a nation's signature. And the best flags, like signatures, proclaim a nation's character.

The Union Jack proclaims the union of English, Scottish and Irish kingdoms. The Union Jack is composed of the Queen's badges for those lands. In fact, all Commonwealth flags are the Queen's badges for the countries and people they designate. If some flag or flags other than the Red Ensign be adopted for Canada, it or they should proclaim Canada's unique character. Canada had two founding nations, Old Britain and New France. Is there any reason why Canada should not have two Queen's flag-badges?

History Should Dictate. From time to time, Britons and Irishmen have complained about the Union Jack. The English cross is superimposed upon the Scottish and Irish crosses. Welshmen complain that no element of their gold and red banner has ever been incorporated into the Union Jack. An Union flag or flags adopted for Canada should give our founding races symbols adequate, indeed equal, prominence. And as British history has dictated what Britain's flag should be, Canada's history should be allowed to dictate what Canada's flag or flags should be.

Modern Canada began when the British won Quebec. The British then had the good sense to leave the French Canadians free to be themselves. Canadians today should be wise. And they should be aware of confusing National Unity and national uniformity.

TWO VARIATIONS

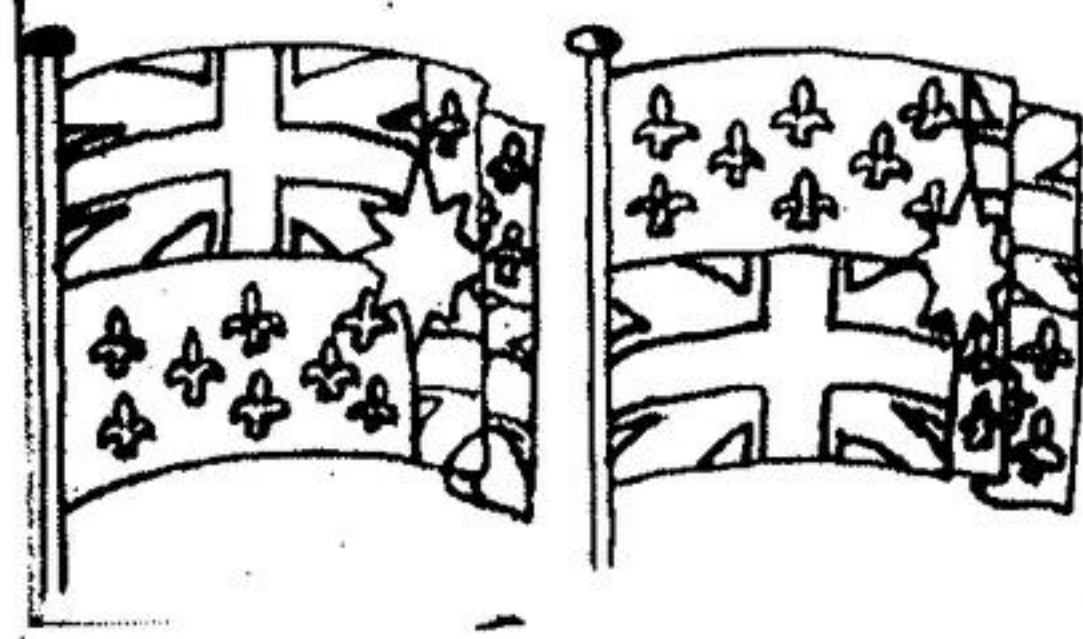
Two flags, or more accurately, two variations of one family flag would suffice. The component banners could perhaps be the flags under which Wolfe and Montcalm served and died. The British flag in 1759 was the earlier Union Jack which contained only the crosses of England and Scot-

land. The French flag was the Cornette Blanche, the white and gold flag under which Canada was colonized. And, to belong to the glories of the missionary martyrs, Brebeuf and Lallemande, and soldier heroes such as Dillard, the quartering of these splendid banners would give Canada flags entirely her own.

"Quartering" is a heraldic method of incorporating inherited family insignia. The Queen's coat of arms are the best known examples. She has a different arrangement for England, Scotland and Ireland. In a sense all Canadians have inherited the flags mentioned above. Would it not be appropriate to arrange one flag in which the Union Jack "dominates" and another in which the Cornette Blanche "dominates"? And could not individual Canadians fly the one they preferred?

But what about our recent immigrants? Members of families using coats of arms, add individual marks. Would not a conventional representation of the guiding North Star be a suitable addition to commemorate all who in Canada's later years came seeking Canada and the freedom and hope she holds out to all who will give to her their vision and vigour.
