**Electrical Storm Plays Havoc With Phones**

At least 3 Georgetown houses and probably more tasted the wrath of the electrical storm which dropped three inches of rain and several lightning bolts here Tuesday.

In each case the lightning entered the home via the TV lead-in.

At the home of Mr. and Mrs. Dan Sweeney, 6 Arletta St. a crack of lightning almost created a serious fire.

Here the electrical charge ruined a TV receiver in the basement apartment of Miss Sally Thornton of the Halton County Health Unit and started a chair ablaze.

Mrs. Sweeney discovered the fire when she returned home about five minutes after the bolt struck and managed to put down the flames with the assistance of neighbours.

The lightning also did some damage to the ceiling in the upstairs part of the house.

Two streets away, at 8 Dufferin St., another electrical blast knocked a TV out of commission and showered sparks all over the living room of Mr. and Mrs. Norm Lounds.

Direct hit number three damaged a television set, blackened part of a wall and scorched window drapes in the home of Mr. and Mrs. Norman Lawrie, 77 Mountview Road.

Mrs. Lawrie said the charge melted every fuse in the fuse box and left a cloud of smoke in the living room.

Though no other direct hit was reported, police and fire departments report having received dozens of calls from people whose light bulbs were popped by near misses, or whose phones went dead after an particularly potent blast.

Three street light relays on Mercury vapour and 120 street light bulbs were all casualties of the lightning bolts in the Main Street North area.
