A stabilization fund has been formed by 27 of the county medical co-operatives to enable them to guarantee their continued health protection in the event of any financial difficulty. This will ensure that no co-op member will ever lose any money through a failure of his co-op. Eye care will probably be the next benefit offered by the Ontario medical co-ops. The Ontario Medical Co-operative Association has reported that they had spent many hours on an insurance plan to cover even the cost of glasses. The Ontario government is considering a bill to control chiropractic benefits.
