

### Ex-Chief Tells Ambulancemen "Don't Take Driving Risks"

Georgetown Volunteer Ambulance drivers were told that it is far better to drive at normal speeds and make sure the patient reaches hospital than to wildly disregard the rules of safe driving on an emergency run and place the patient and their own in danger.

Issuing the word of caution was a former ambulance chief Ed Hall. He said that the GVAS has a fine reputation and can maintain it by sticking to the rules of the road while on emergency runs.

It is important that the person entrusted to the GVAS' care during a run to hospital makes it there quickly, but it is more important that he or she makes it there safely, he told those assembled for the dinner.

He reminded the drivers that they were taking too much on themselves when they close a coast through stop streets or break the speed limit. He said they as head of their families had a responsibility to the other members of their families as well as to the injured.
