It's late to be commenting on the assassination of President Kennedy. Most of the words associated with the act of violence — tragedy, shock, horror — have already been used.

Whatever we are — friends, neighbours, brothers — we have a relationship that is unequalled in the world. We exchange visits, gifts and citizens. We even exchange epithets. But we never exchange blows and cruelties and treachery.

We learned of the shooting with horrified disbelief. Our reaction was that of a man who learns that the neighbour with whom he has argued over minor things, with whom he has visited, with whom he has fought against brutality and tyranny, has been killed by a sneak thief.

We have more than the two million, probably, than any other nation in the world. We have a common heritage of language, law, and history. We are both young and old. We are both included by the brother.

Think of us as brothers. The U.S. is the big brother, grown up, wealthy, powerful, past rebellious nature of his youth, but still containing the lurking violence which told the old man to go to blazes, and made it sticky. The older brother is steady to settle down, raise a family and enjoy what his strength and hard work have created for him.

Canada is the younger brother, a little more cautious, just beginning to feel his own strength, but just as determined to be rich and successful just as hard as he is going to the north. He is the brother's big spread to the south, and he is respectful of his big brother's paternal attitude and he is admiring the people throughout his brother, not just a kid brother.

When somebody else picks a fight, the brothers find themselves on the same side, slugging it out with all they've got. When it's peaceful, they squabble with each other, as brothers have since the beginning of time.

ANNEXATION BID SLATED FOR JAN. 16 HEARING

Georgetown's bid to annex a portion of Esquesing Township land on which part of the South & Stone plant and the Meadowlark Mushroom property is located will come before the Municipal Board on January 16th.

A board hearing has been set for 10:30 a.m. that morning in Georgetown and hear the town's case and any objection from the township or owners of the land affected.

Georgetown wishes to acquire the property for possible future industrial development. The town also claims that town services are already being provided for the portion of the South & Stone plant lying in the township and the taxes available should rightly be assigned to the local treasury.
