"We have never had a bad report on the water in the swimming pool here at Terra Cotta in the seven years we have operated the area," H. H. Parker emphasized at an executive meeting of the Credit Valley Conservation Authority. Mr. Parker is Chairman of the Flood Control and Pollution Advisory Board and
