Tony Restivo, 82, whose business career was intimately linked with Georgetown's early days, died at his home in Hamilton on July 11. He started a fruit business in 1912, operating a store in the present McNamara Jewellers location and peddling his produce door-to-door in the town. Older residents will recall that he had his own form of advertising, free bananas for the children on his route. He operated a wholesale fruit business in Hamilton for a few years from 1918, then returned to town and set up business again in what is now the liquor store, later moving to the present Goldham Market premises, and then purchasing the adjacent store where the business has since prospered.
