One of the first things that a novice bridge player learns is how to take a finesse by leading up towards high cards. If one is to progress beyond the novice stage, the next thing he should learn is when not to finesse. As a general rule, you should not finesse when: if the finesse should lose, the contract will be in danger. Here is a hand that occurred last week at the Acton Bridge Club. This is Board No. 18.
