

Some Thoughts On Conservation

Too frequently in the past the concept of conservation has been associated solely with the idea of setting aside suitable areas to preserve particular natural resources for the use and enjoyment of future generations. It is important that the singular and limited interpretation of conservation persists in the minds of many people even today.

Dynamic Approach

No one will argue with the fact that there are certain agricultural phenomena such as

aged stands of virgin pine, the much publicized whooping cranes that have been reduced to dangerously low levels and such awe-inspiring wonders as the Petrified Forest of the State of Arizona, that need to be protected entirely from the woodsmen's saw, the hunter's gun and the pick and hammer of the mineralogist. Also, there is no argument with the fact that had some semblance of a protection policy been adopted by our forefathers, the annihilation of the passenger pigeon and the near depletion of

the buffalo might well have been prevented.

N nonetheless, in line with current advancements in thinning in all fields of science and technology, a much more dynamic approach to the overall management of our natural resources has become firmly established, which is logically based on a policy of WISE USE.

Game Preserves

The efforts of conservationists are now directed towards maintaining the maximum use of the greatest number of natural resources that will contribute to the greatest public welfare for the longest duration of time. As an example, game preserves are not nearly so popular as they once were, although it must be admitted that they do have their value in particular situations.

There is little sense in restricting hunting over a large area if numbers of deer or other game animals will increase to the point where the available food supply will not support the population.

It is more sensible to harvest the surplus population and maintain a production of vigorous animals that will be free from the ravages of malnutrition and disease.

Long Term Benefits

Indeed, we have learned some valuable lessons in resource management and with the "wise use" concept we appear to be on the right road. However, we cannot afford to be complacent, since we are faced with increasingly complex problems in the optimum maintenance of our renewable natural resources —

re-four soils, waters, forests, wild-life and most important of all our human population. Are we willing to forego immediate gains in our agricultural and industrial efforts in order to reap the long-term benefits that will invariably provide?

With respect to water pollution — while much has been accomplished here in Ontario are we willing to accept the costs of achieving increasingly expensive objectives that will forestall the continuing deterioration of our lakes and streams? Will our Conservation Authorities receive the support they need to acquire public land along river valleys so that sound erosion and flood control measures may be used eventually have to be used to demonstrate to future generations what a wonderful outdoor heritage we once possessed.
