

Licence Deadline Nearing Only 20% Have New Plates

With only two weeks to go to the deadline to obtain 1966 car plates, sales are very slow according to Department of Transport officials in Toronto.

Locally the situation is much the same as elsewhere. The Herald was told by Registrar Mrs. L. Clark. "Sales have been quite slow to date. However, it is following much the same pattern as last year, and I expect a definite pick-up in sales by the week-end. People in town usually start to get around to obtaining their new February licences. However, I should advise drivers to obtain them in

the next few days, to avoid the inconvenience of a line-up. I say this because as yet only about 20% have obtained their plates, and if they delay too long, it could mean waiting in line."

The first of the drivers' permits are being renewed. These are the ones that were good for only a year period, instead of a longer (up to 3 year) period. These can be renewed at the local Dept. of Transport office, merely by presenting the form received in the mail, and having it stamped.

The Dept. of Transport office, located at 41 Main Street, South, is open six days a week - until

the deadline. The hours are 9 a.m. until 12.00 noon in the mornings; 1.00 p.m. until 5.30 in the afternoons and on Saturdays from 9.00 until 4.00 p.m.

This year the last date for 1966 plates to be legal falls on Sunday, February 28th. This means, of course, that the last day plates will be sold before the deadline will be Saturday, February 27th.
