BRAMPTON — Ontario Chief Justice G. A. Gale has objected to the design of Peel County's proposed ultra-modern court house, but Peel County Council will proceed with the \$1,600,000 windowless steel and concrete structure anyway. Critics say it looks like a futuristic circus.

BRAMBLEA — Councillor James Cathcart of Bramblea has made an appeal to the township public school board to properly equip the school auditoriums. Mr. Cathcart said there are schools which have basketball courts but no baskets.

HILLSBURGH — Gloria Hall, formerly of Hillsburgh, presented her senior organ recital at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago recently. Miss Hall is a 1942 graduate of Guelph Collegiate and Vocational Institute.
