Born on Family Farm Slated for Industry

Born on an expanding farm which now is part of Georgetown's Delrex subdivision, Mrs. Seward Wilson, 80, died in Georgetown Hospital on August 11.

Mrs. Wilson was the former Edith Pearl Cleave, daughter of James and Charlotte Walker Cleave. The farm was purchased in 1904 by Delrex Developments and is now part of the Delrex industrial acreage on the east end of the highway approach to town. She attended Normal Public School, and following their marriage Mr. and Mrs. Wilson moved to the 5th Line, Georgetown. They retired and moved to 1 Guelph Street, Georgetown, fifteen years ago.

Mrs. Wilson was a past president of Georgetown Women's Institute and a member of Knox Presbyterian Church and the Scotch Block Circle of the Women's Association.

Her husband predeceased her in 1962. She leaves two children Mrs. Hyatt McClure (Charlton) 1122, Brampton and Charles of Burlington; four grandchildren and two brothers Lester and Wilbert Cleave of Georgetown. She was predeceased by brothers Robert and George.

Rev. K. Duncan conducted the funeral service on Monday in Knox Presbyterian Church. Pallbearers were five nephews, Frank, Donald and James Cleave, Cameron Wilson and William McDowell, and James McCabane. Interment was in Greenwood Cemetery.
