A 18 years old Georgetown youth, whose name was not released, was witness to a fatal accident on the 1st Line of Georgetown late Friday night in which a retired Milton Brick employee was knocked down by a pickup truck.

Dead is Anelo Nadalin, age 70, of R.R. 3 Milton. He died shortly after being struck by the truck less than a half mile from his home. Mr. Nadalin was apparently walking across the 1st Line crossing at a bridge just north of the Base Line when he was hit.

The driver of the truck was John Arthur Bayton of R.R. 1, Campbellville. Three weeks ago Mr. Nadalin retired from the brick company and a party was held in his honour by the firm. Funeral service was Monday.
