

Haltom Dairy Princess Has Busy Weekly Schedule

The life of a dairy princess isn't easy, the schedule of Haltom's dairy princesses shows.

Margaret Hunter, 19, of RR 1 Burlington is engaged in a busy round of school, 4-H club, junior farmer and home and farm activities.

Uncontested, she was acclaimed the county's dairy princess at Hornby Garden Party July 17. She was busy before receiving the honour.

She has two sisters and no brothers. "That's why I spend most of my time in the barn," she quips.

She and her sister Lois who is younger help their father with the 25 head milking herd.

Her sister Marion who is older and now married, won the dairy princess title in 1962.

Margaret's farm chores start around Easter time when she comes home from attending school near Ottawa.

She'll be starting her second year of a two year home economic course this fall. She attends Kempenville Agricultural School.

Adding to her activities, she has been working as a food supervisor at Brant Memorial Hospital in Burlington this summer.

She is president of the Holstein 4-H Club and a member of the 4-H grain and conservation clubs also.

She will have a total of 17 4-H agricultural projects to her credit by this year. She has made a number of appearances and given a few speeches so far as the dairy princess.

On Tuesday August 24, she competed in Ontario dairy princess competition at the C.N.E. In addition to a speech and a personal interview she was judged on how she milked a cow.

Haltom County is annually represented in most of the competitions at the Canadian National Exhibition. With the change in prize money this year in the Dairy and Beef Classes, there has been an increase in interest in exhibiting. Approximately \$10,000 is available in prize money for each breed.

Dairy Cattle were judged Tuesday and Wednesday, August 24th and 25th. Steers are on day, August 27th, Shorthorns on Friday, Aug. 30th; Aberdeen Angus and Hereford on Tuesday, August 31st.

The county 4-H Club Members and Junior Farmers will be represented in the C.N.E. Judging Competition to be held on Friday, September 3rd. Thirty-four contestants will be leaving the Agricultural Office at 7:15 a.m. for the Coliseum. In addition to judging dairy, sheep and swine classes, they will complete tractor, safety and livestock quizzes; identify tractor parts, weeds, forage plants and forage seeds. That evening the young people will be guests of the C.N.E. grandstand show. A practice for this competition was held in the Agricultural office, Milton, on Tuesday, Aug. 31st.
