**4-H Completion Record One of Ontario's Best**  
The 1966 Annual Meeting of the Halton County 4-H Club Leaders Council was held on Wednesday, Feb. 2nd, in the Board Room, Ontario Department of Agriculture, Milton.

After the meeting was opened by Chairman Jim McKay, Henry J. Stanley, Agricultural Representative for Halton County, gave a brief rundown on the past year's program, and mentioned that Halton County 4-H members had 97% completion of their 4-H projects in 1965 — one of the highest in the province. He went on to say that 4-H Conservation clubs, and the new Senior Dairy projects, will be offered on a province-wide basis for this year, after completing a successful trial period in three counties, of which Halton County was one.

A new club to be offered in 1966 is the Halton H Strawberry Club, under the direction of Charles Warner, Fruit and Vegetable Extension Specialist, and Bill Wilson, President of the Club Leaders' Council.
