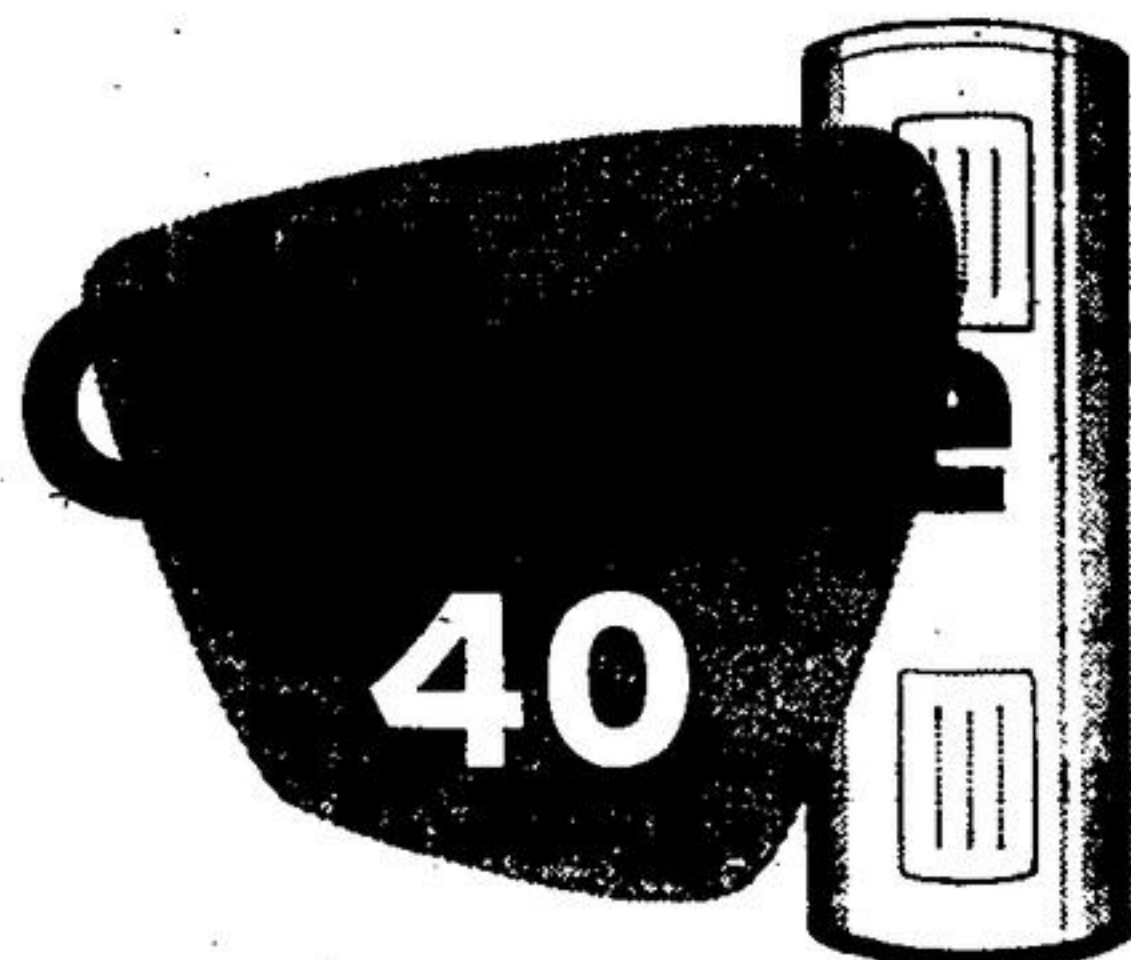

LET'S PLAY BRIDGE

Have you ever walked away from the bridge table with the feeling that you could have played a certain hand better than you did?

Occasionally, however, even at duplicate bridge you play a hand at such an unusual contract that even the other results don't help.

Board No. 16 North-South vulnerable. Dealer — North.

North S-K 9 5 3 H-J 10 9 3 2 D-9 3 2 C-5 West S-A J 2 H-Q 8 7 6 5 4 H-A D-6 4 C-A K Q 10 8 7 C-J 8 7 6 C-K 9 2 South S-Q 10 7 6 4 H-K D-J 5 C-A Q 10 4 3

The bidding: North East South West Pass 1 D 2 C Pass Pass 2 S Pass Pass 3 D Pass Pass 3 S Dbl. All Pass

I was sitting in the East position. You may question my opening bid of one diamond on such a strong hand but that is the style I use. I reserve diamond bids for hands that virtually assure us of game.

overcalls were purely competitive and worked out quite well. No other table played the hand at spades.

West led the diamond six which I won. I now cashed the ace of hearts, the ace of diamonds, and led the diamond queen. All we had to do was take two spade tricks to defeat the contract.

Declarer ruffed the third diamond trumps. He cashed the ace of clubs and ruffed a club in dummy. He now led a heart. Not wishing to be overruled, I discarded the club king while declarer ruffed low.

I had the feeling that somehow I had not defended too well. Can you find the error? If I let declarer ruff the third club with the spade king and I do not overruff, we must make 2 spades.
