

Lorne Scots Regiment Marks 100th Anniversary At Riviera

George P. Vanier, Governor General of Canada has consented to be present at the Trooping of the Colours ceremony by the Lorne Scots Regiment on June 19. The announcement by Bruce Beer MP for Peel brought applause from the two hundred couples gathered at the Riviera, Norval, Friday night to celebrate the regiment's 100th anniversary.

The Hon. Earl Rowe, Lieutenant Governor of Ontario, spoke to the gathering mentioning that he felt himself a member of the Lorne Scots. He said, "I feel proud to be here tonight and proud to be associated with you."

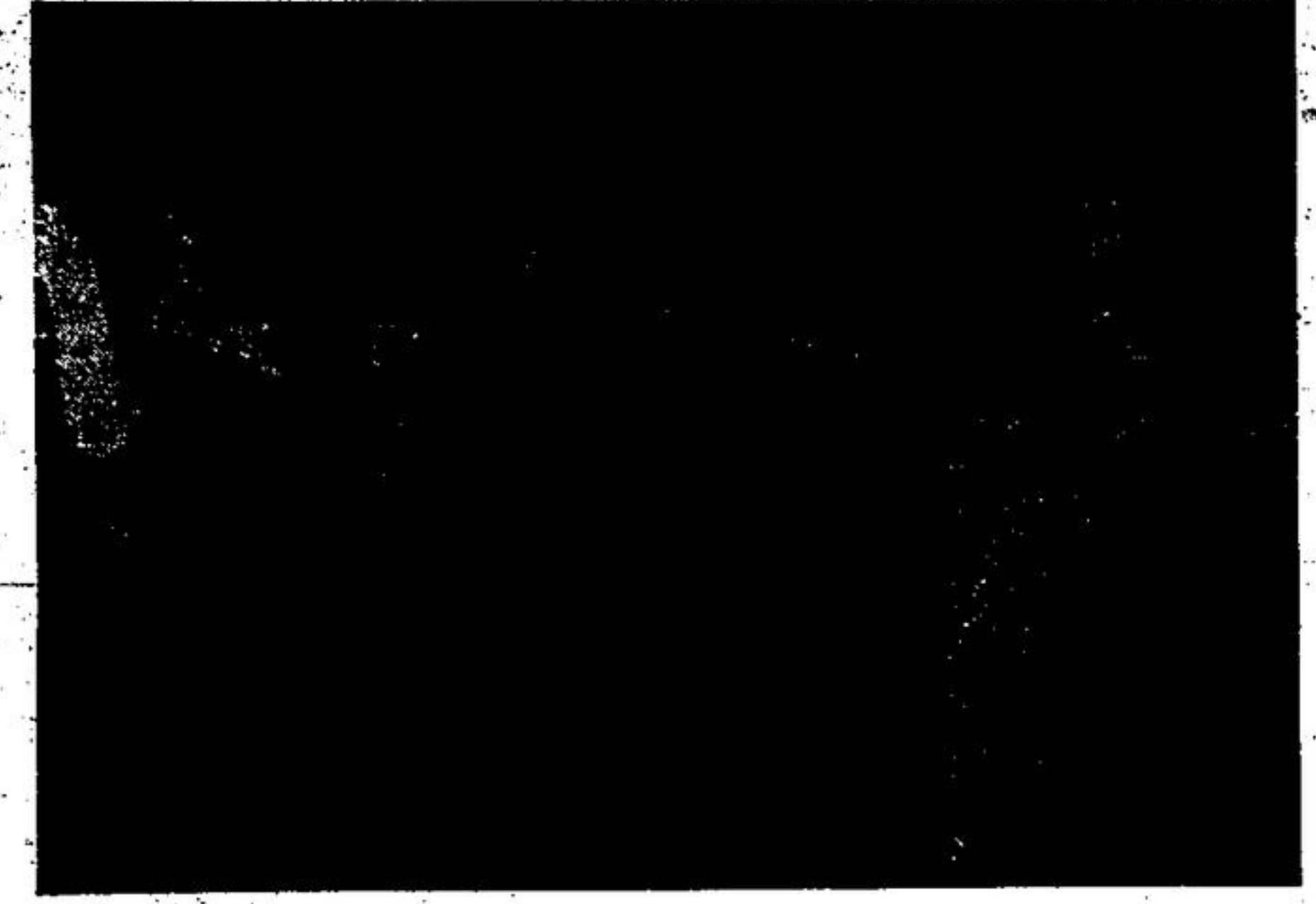
The Lieutenant Governor congratulated the officers and men of the Regiment and their 100 years, and referred to their basic loyalty and traditions.

Mr. Rowe read a telegram from Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II thanking all ranks of the Lorne Scots for their loyalty.

Start Registering For Summer Work

Registration of students for summer work is now under way at the National Employment Service, Brampton, announced Mr. C.B. Fraser, Local Manager. Last summer 808 students registered with the N.E.S. and 298 of them were placed in jobs for at least part of the summer.

Many of the registered students who were not placed by the N.E.S. found their own jobs in various occupations.

Girls were referred to jobs in offices, stores, plants and also harvesting operations.

Boys worked on construction, on plant maintenance, in factories, on farms, in offices, stores service stations and as truck drivers, life guards and security guards.

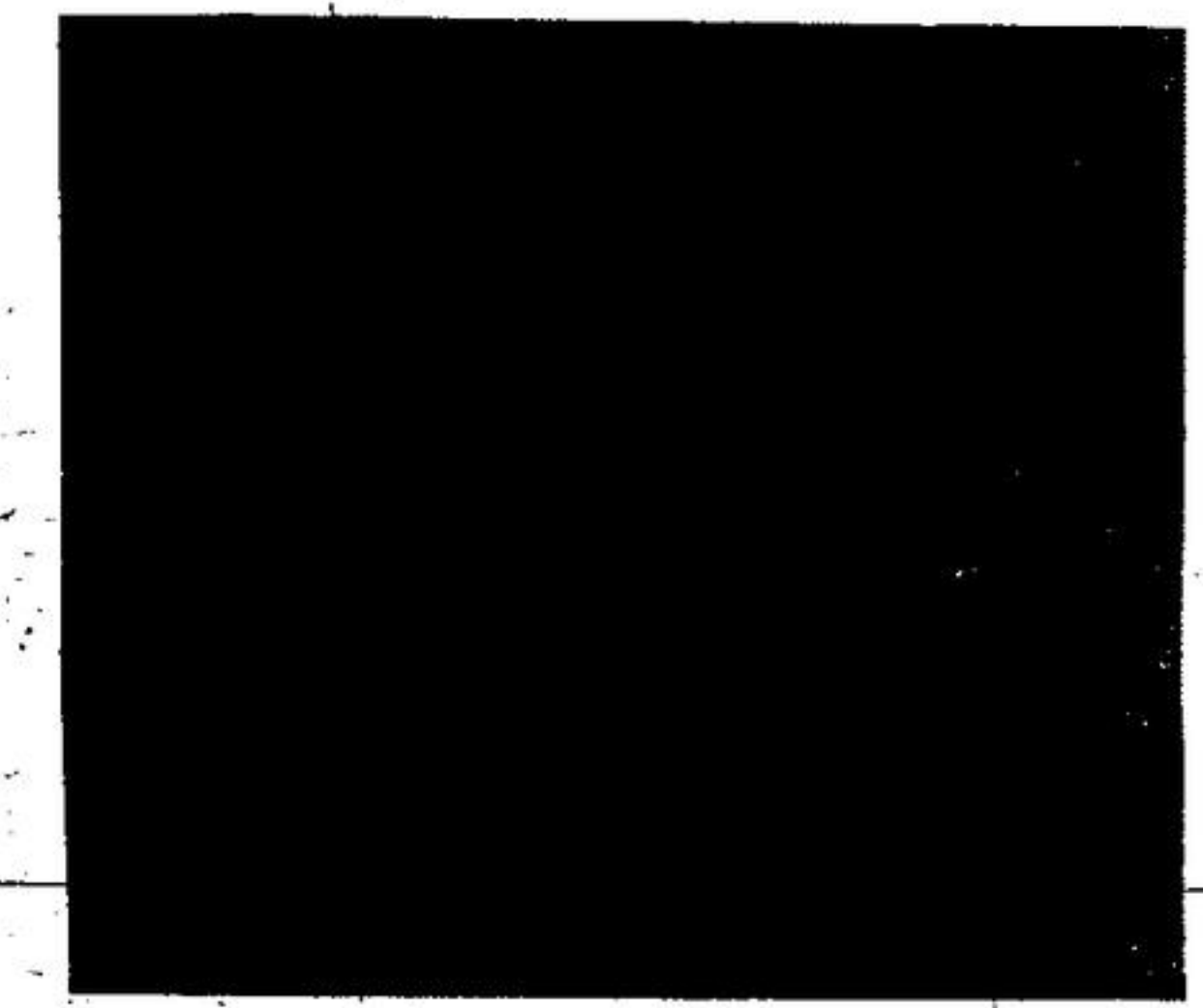
