

Chatham Grand Champion in Bantam Hockey Tournament Last Week

The International Bantam Hockey Tournament's Most Valuable Player, Mike Marvell, scored two first period goals and assisted on a third to lead Chatham Bantams to the Grand Championship in the final game with Winnipeg Saturday night.

Chatham, who had won the Bantams title earlier the same year, dropped the A. Division title to the winners 3 to 2.

Grant scored Chatham's third goal breaking a tie after Hunt and McCheyne had knotted it

for the westerners.

The Grand Championship game climaxed a week of playoff hockey involving 44 teams from Ontario, Manitoba, Quebec, New York State and Michigan — about 938 young players and another hundred coaches and managers.

Those coming a distance were billeted in local homes and took their main meals at the Branch 120 Legion Hall.

Tourney president Rod

Asseltine is already thinking ahead to next year when he predicts a bigger emphasis on the international angle. He told the Herald that a team from Mexico is a possibility for next year, and Chicago, Utah, Dearborn and St. Clair Shores are four more U.S. teams to indicate they want in.

He has even made a long-range forecast that the day is not far off when a European entry will be scrambling for local tournament honours.

Chatham gained the finals by beating B Division winners, Copper Cliff, 8 to 4.

Winnipeg made it by blanking Georgetown, C. Division champs, 4-0—even-though-Georgetown fired more shots at the Winnipeg team than any other team they met.

In other games played Saturday, Winnipeg took the A crown with a 6-2 victory over Kitchener; Chatham downed Waterloo 5-2 to cop the B title, Georgetown bumped Learning-

ton 3-2 for the C championship, and Copper Cliff rode over Essex 4-1 for the D honours.
