

Georgetown Tie-In With Belfield Still To Be Finalized, Tells Lions

First hand information about major improvements planned for traffic in the Georgetown-Melo Toronto area was given to members of Georgetown Lions Club at their dinner meeting last week at Stan's Restaurant.

Walter McNe, traffic and planning studies engineer for the Ontario highway department, brought illustrated charts to depict the highway network which will serve the area in the next twenty years. Of particular local interest is the Belfield Freeway which will link Georgetown with Metro.

"If anyone tells you where the route to Georgetown will be, he didn't hear it from my department," he said, stressing that no final route has been chosen to connect Georgetown with Highway 27.

He said that while making No. 7 highway a four-lane highway has been discussed, he doubts if this would happen because of the alignment of the road. No property has been acquired, he said.

"All we know is that there will be a freeway from Belfield to service as far as Georgetown. There is no definite

line, I make that very clear," he said.

He outlined the difficulties which face major road revisions, where one change cannot be made without changes elsewhere, while faced with the problem of moving traffic while construction is underway.

A new 403 highway from Burlington, linking up with 401 east of No. 27 is definite. Widening of the Queen Elizabeth is also on the drawing boards.

One difficulty is the traffic pattern which is oriented east to west, but has many north-south roads. The department makes projections as if no roads existed, then must tie these into existing roads where possible.

He cited present capacity of roads funneling traffic into and through Toronto at 100,000 daily, and highways must be improved to provide almost twice this number in the next twenty years.

Mr. McNe was introduced by Lyn McLaren and thanked for his talk by Don Clark.

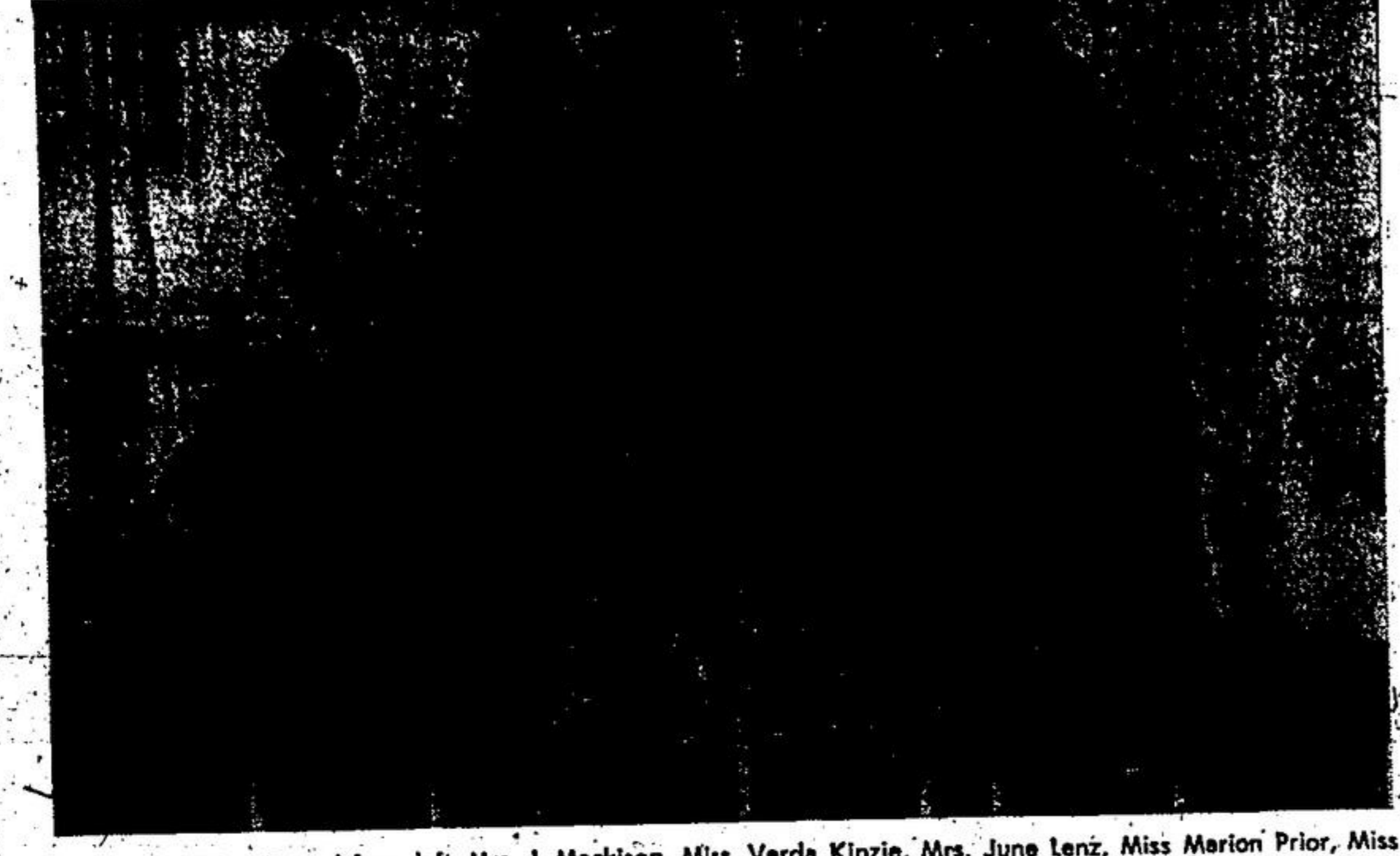
