Bennett, Georgetown, of sire, second in two bulls bred by an exhibitor, third in bull born between May 1, 1965, and Dec. 31, 1965, first in bull born between Feb. 1st, 1965, and April 30, 1965, second in bull born between Jan. 1, 1964, and Jan. 31, 1965, first in female born in 1965, first in female born between Jan. 1 1964, and Dec. 31, 1964, and second for female with calf at foot.

**County Dairy Herds Advance in DHIA**

Halton County herds have showed considerable improvement in the 1965 progress report of the D.H.I.A. The average production of the 59 associations across Ontario for the past year was 10,606 lbs. of milk, 388 lbs. of butterfat. West Halton Association with George McCormack as supervisor moved from 10th position to 4th in the Province. The 440 cows complete record production was 11,543 lbs. of milk, 446 lb. of fat for a breed class average of 112 and 113.

East Halton Association, under Frank Chisholm moved from 16th to 13th position with 11,168 lbs. of milk, 430 lbs. of fat for a BCA of 106 and 110. Halton Centre under Howard King moved from 26th to 19th with 11,215 of milk and 428 of butterfat, 106 and 106 BCA.

The total of 1,315 grade herds were tested during the past year. Halton had 8 herds out of the top 30 compared to just 3 in 1964. Highest production in this county went to Walter Egger, Milton No. 8, West Halton Association - 14,646, 570 for a BCA of 136 and 143; (7th in Ontario); 11th S. W. Waters, Georgetown No. 2, East Halton Association - 14,009, 565 for a BCA of 132 and 140; 15th, R. Lawrence, Milton No. 1, West Halton - 14,290, 535 for a BCA of 133 and 136; 16th, Galbraith Bros.

In addition to receiving the following report on the production of each cow in the herd, each D.H.I.A. member received a report on the cost of production of milk and the profit per cow in his herd. He then is able to change his management and cull the poor production in an attempt to improve his profits.
