The finesse is one of the elementary plays at contract bridge. I suppose that right after learning how to take ace and king, the new bridge player learns how to take a finesse. If he is ever going to learn to play bridge well, the next thing to learn is when not to take a finesse.

I was reminded of this last week at the Action Bridge Club on the following hand.

Neither side vulnerable.
