I have asked some of the two year councillors who are hoping to get re-elected, a little. The only plan that I could get was that I enable them to finish an item they had started about as childish a bit as can be attributed to an official who handles town affairs.

I would like the voters' election day to consider the possible consequences of a two year term and vote out the councillors who so conveniently passed this by-law. Or we might be stuck with a perpetual council as lethargic as our Ottawa Senate.
