Georgetown's largest "restaurant"....

Over seven hundred people a day are fed in the biggest restaurant in town — the high school cafeteria.

In a brief two hour period they fill through, make their choice, eat their lunch, and make way for the next batch of hungry students.

Top in choice are french fried potatoes followed by shepherd's pie, and hot beef pie. But french fried potatoes with ketchup can accompany anything.

Mrs. Alice Hutchison, who is in charge of feeding your high schoolers feel there's a lot of candy bars being consumed and that the girls especially may regret when the pounds creep up.

Many bring their own lunch, and buy milk and dessert at the school.

There's an electric potato peeler to provide the mountain of french fries which disappear daily, and an electric dishwasher to take care of the dish-washing chore.

The five full time workers in the kitchen are, Mrs. Alice Hutchison in charge, Mrs. R. McAusland, Mrs. H. Levers, Mrs. A. Harvey. In addition there are two part time workers.

It may not be the Royal York but as the menu in the photograph shows, neither are the prices in that range.

Hospital Handles 1715 Patients In 11 Months

A hundred and sixty six adults and children were admitted into Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital during the month of November the monthly statistical report issued this week reveals.

It brings to 1,715 the total number of children and adults admitted during the first 11 months of 1966. The newborn in Nov. numbered 25, bringing that total for 11 months to 295.

There were two deaths in hospital last month, the 25th and 26th of the year.

One hundred and forty-two people made emergency visits to the hospital during the month.
