
# Operation Hungry Horde' Feeds 700 High School Students Daily

### **Hospital Handles** 1715 Patients In 11 Months

A hundred and sixty six adults and children were admitted into Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital during the month of November the monthly statistical report issued this week reveals.

It brings to 1,715 the total number of children and adults admitted during the first 11 months of 1966. The newborn in Nov. numbered 25, bringing that total for 11 months to 295.

There were two deaths in hospital last month, the 25th and 26th of the year.
