Time Wins Damage Suit

WASHINGTON (AP) — The U.S. Supreme Court threw out Monday a \$30,000 damage award against Time Inc. The vote was 6 to 3.

The award, to the James J. Hill family of Old Greenwich, Conn., had been made under New York state privacy law. Both the award and the law were challenged by Time, on the grounds of press freedom guarantees in the U.S. Constitution.

In the controlling opinion, Justice William J. Brennan Jr. said that, under the free speech guarantees, damage awards for a magazine article such as was involved here can only be made on a showing that the article was published "with knowledge of its falsity or in reckless disregard of the truth."

Because the trial court did not so instruct the jury, Brennan said for the majority, the award against Time Inc. cannot stand.

The carefully narrow ruling left the New York privacy law standing.

The award arose from an article in Life magazine Feb. 28, 1955. It linked the play, The Desperate Hours, with the experiences of the Hill family, who had been held hostage in their home by three escaped convicts in 1952.

Former vice-president Richard M. Nixon represented the Hills during two rounds of Supreme Court argument. Nixon accused Life of "substantial falsity and complete falsity" in likening events in the play to what happened to the Hills when they were held hostage.

Harold R. Medina Jr., lawyer for Time Inc., defended the article as "basically true." He said the Hills' experiences were a "public fact" and that the picture-article used "non-defamatory language about a public fact."

A jury returned a verdict awarding the family \$175,000 in damages. This later was reduced to \$30,000. Time Inc. appealed to the Supreme Court from New York state courts.

Approve Three Loans For Sewage Projects

OTTAWA (CP) — Central Mortgage and Housing Corp. recently announced approval of loans totalling \$115,700 for sewage treatment projects in two Ontario communities and one in Nova Scotia.

The Ontario loans, with an interest rate of 6 1/2 per cent annually, go to:

- Burlington, \$87,033 towards the \$153,050 cost of installing a 2,900-foot 36-inch trunk collector sewer.
- Aurora, Ont., \$16,887 towards the \$25,000 cost of converting and enlarging the existing sewage treatment plant.

For work completed before March 31, 1970, CMHC may forgive repayment of 25 per cent of the principal of the loan and 25 per cent of the accrued interest.

Gold Reserve Shows Drop

OTTAWA (CP) — Official holdings of gold and U.S. dollars amounted to \$2,235,900,000 in terms of U.S. dollars on Dec. 31, compared with \$2,242,100,000 at the end of November, the finance department announced recently.

The official holdings are made up of the exchange fund account, Bank of Canada holdings and funds held by the finance ministry.

In addition to the official holdings, Canada had a net creditor position in the International Monetary Fund amounting to \$263,500,000 at Dec. 31, compared with \$267,500,000 on Nov. 30.

The total of official holdings and equivalent in exchange reserves was \$2,499,400,000 at Dec. 31, little changed from \$2,506,600,000 at Nov. 30.

Vertical Take-Off For Interceptor?

MOSCOW (Reuters) — Russia has developed an accelerator device which gives its jet interceptor aircraft an almost vertical take-off, the newspaper Komсомolskaya Pravda says.

The Communist youth daily says the device shortened a plane's take-off run by nearly 10 times and put it 60,000 feet into the stratosphere within minutes.

The newspaper does not say how the system works or how many aircraft are equipped with it, but its description indicates it is some kind of rocket device which the plane jets-on soon after take-off.

MAPPING FROM PHOTOS

VICTORIA (CP) — Axel Klenn, chief of air mapping in the British Columbia department of lands, says federal and provincial governments are experimenting with color photography to see if it is worth the extra cost. Color aerial photographs are sharper in focus and show more detail than those in black and white.
