"If I know you they'll be telling you that you can go home when you like too," joked Mayor Gibbons.

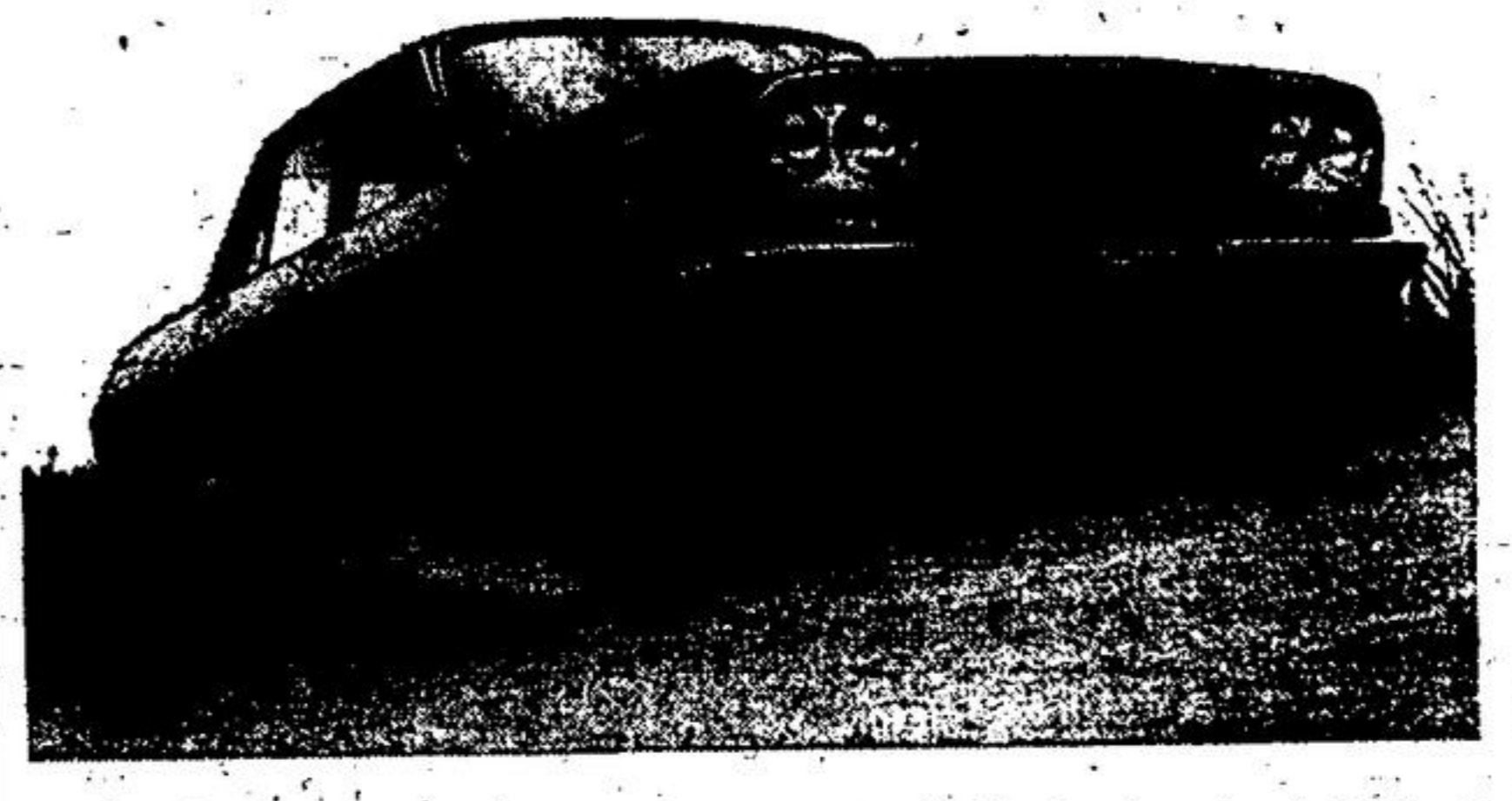
"Seriously," he continued, "a town which pays as much as Georgetown should have a member on the executive and we'll give you any backing you need."
