Vancouver Island May Be Gold Mine

VANCOUVER (CP)—Vancouver Island and the Queen Charlotte Islands have beaches which may be laden with gold, says Dr. James W. Murray, geographer at the University of British Columbia.

Dr. Murray said beaches have been eroded along the coast by shifting tectonic plates which have washed out onto the continental shelf.

He said the main problem is finding gold on the ocean floor and determining the most efficient method of bringing it up.

In the United States, research vessels will soon conduct a major search for gold on the Pacific continental shelf. Persons in the mining industry and geologists at UBC are expected to watch the developments closely.

The vessels will cruise cross the shelf of California, Oregon and Alaska seeking deposits of gold, washed to sea before the great gold rushes of the last century.

Approximately \$100,000,000 in gold was mined from the Klondike Mountains during the American gold rush of 1898, and U.S. geologists believe erosion must have washed away many gold lodes long before the miners arrived.

Legal Advisor Is Vice-Chairman

Mr. Howard D. Brown has been appointed a vice-chairman of the Ontario Labor Relations Board by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. He has recently been named to the position of vice-chairman of the board.

Mr. Brown, 32, received his education at Hamilton Central Collegiate and Burlington District High School. After receiving his Bachelor of Arts degree from McMaster University, he attended Osgoode Hall Law School and was awarded a Bachelor of Law degree in 1958. He was called to the Ontario Bar that year.

Mr. Brown was engaged in the general practice of law in Brantford from 1958 to 1964. He then joined the Saint Lawrence Seaway Authority as a legal advisor. During his period of service with the authority, he was actively engaged in labor relations matters arising out of the new twin-lake project on the Welland Canal. He worked with both employers and trade unions involved in the construction work on the canal.

Mr. Brown resides with his family in Burlington.

Dining Spot Gone Bears Go To Town

KITIMAT, B.C. (CP)—Tourists in this northern B.C. area are becoming a little wary of black bears fed up with the town dump.
