The conference made use of facilities at the YMCA camp there. Sessions included program management, weekly activities, and how to deal with problems that arise out of working with a group of boys in this age bracket.

Headquarters staff and local leaders, led discussion groups on subjects ranging from discipline to praise for boys advancing in the achievement program. Speakers included Kay Dalton, office manager at Headquarters office in Wheaton, Illinois, Rev. Arman Wright, the protestant chaplain at the Ontario Reformatory in Guelph, and Rev. Murray Worozbyt, Eastern Canada Division Director.

Four of the speakers came up through the ranks and achieved the highest award in Christian Service Brigade 'The Herald of Christ' these young men were Gary Lane, Keith Hadzimek both of Toronto, Robert Swan, Hamilton and Bill Huggins of Brampton.

• Authorized the issuing of \$11,000 to Library Board, which is the balance of their \$16,000 grant.

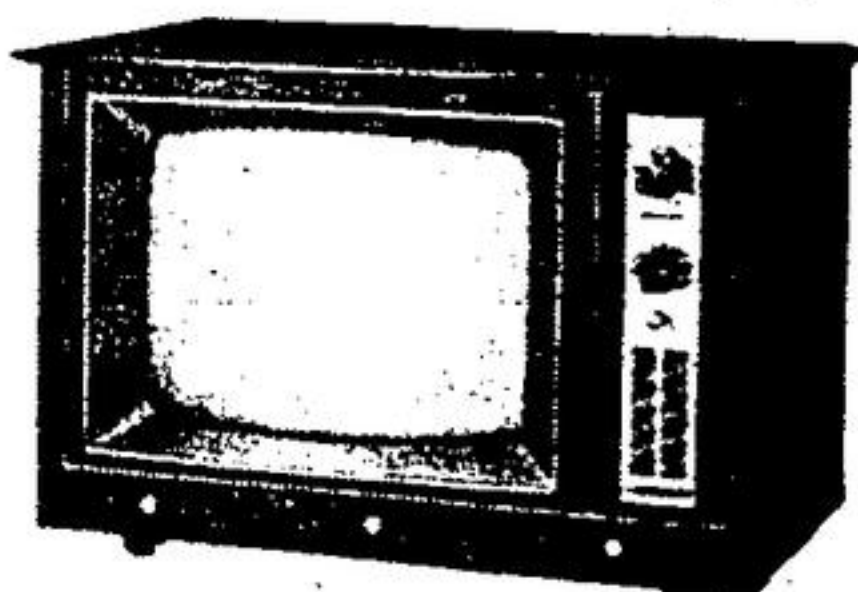
• Authorized the town foreman to hire J. Quabury, C.E. Gerbett and D. McMurdo, for the works department.

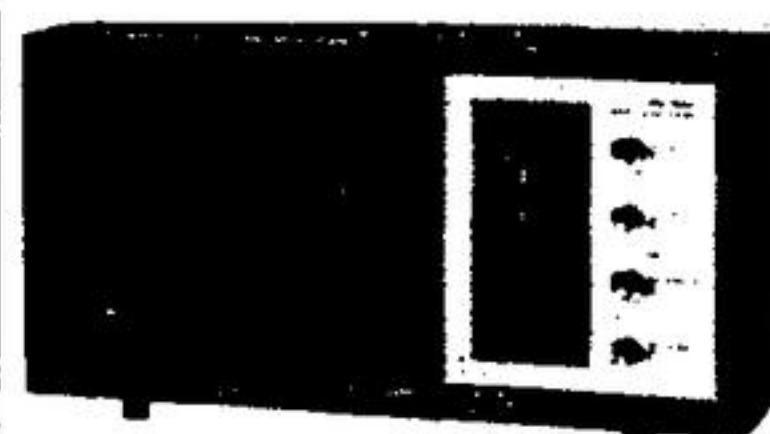
