

Here Are Some Things We All Can Do



Clear the house of rubbish, oily rags,

Check heating system for cracks and clogging. See that woodwork isn't too close to smoke and heat pipes. Have plenty of ash trays. Don't smoke

in bed. Keep matches in metal containers: out of reach of children.

Do not use inflammable cleaning fluids in the home.

Beware of frayed electric cords;

don't use over-size fuses.

Keep dead grass and refuse away from buildings.

Observe fire precautions 52 weeks of the year.
