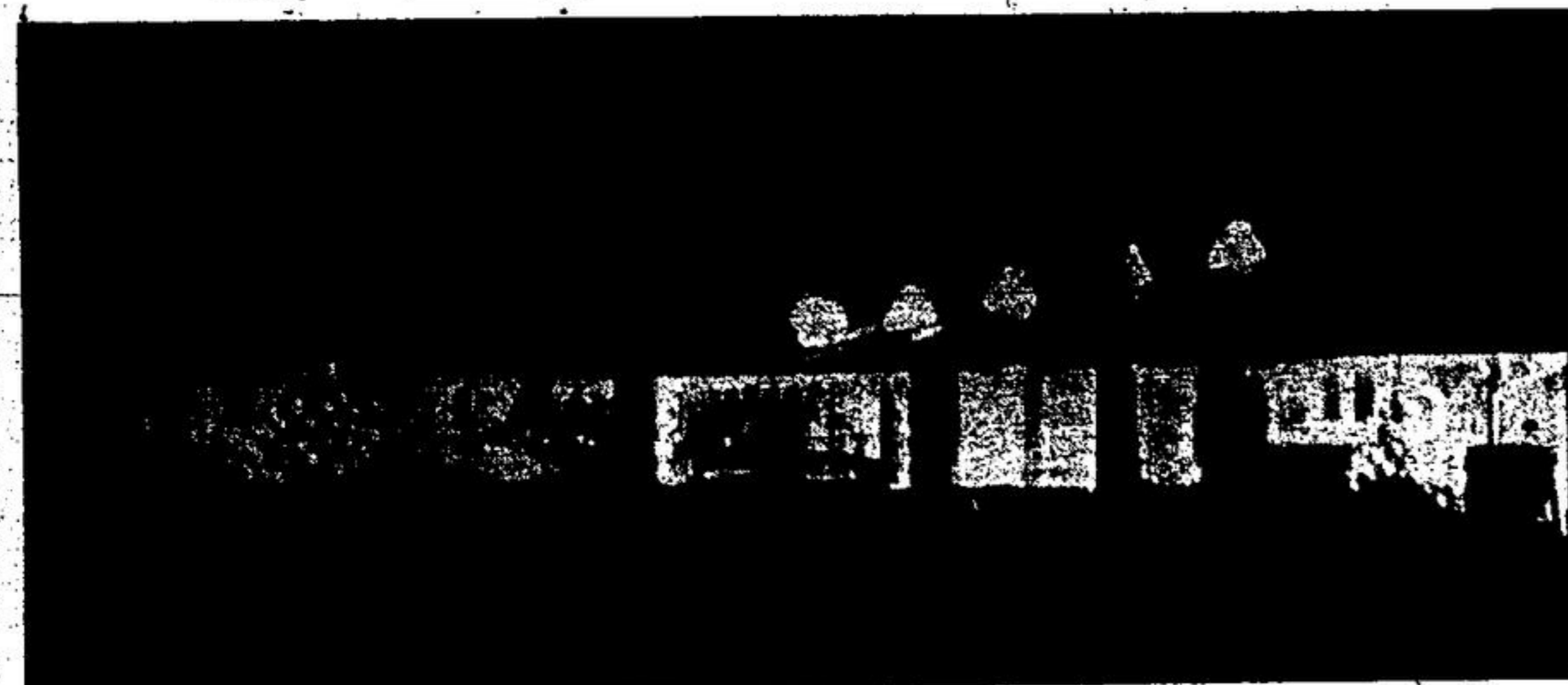


Outdoor Lighting Turns Town Into Sparkling Greeting Card

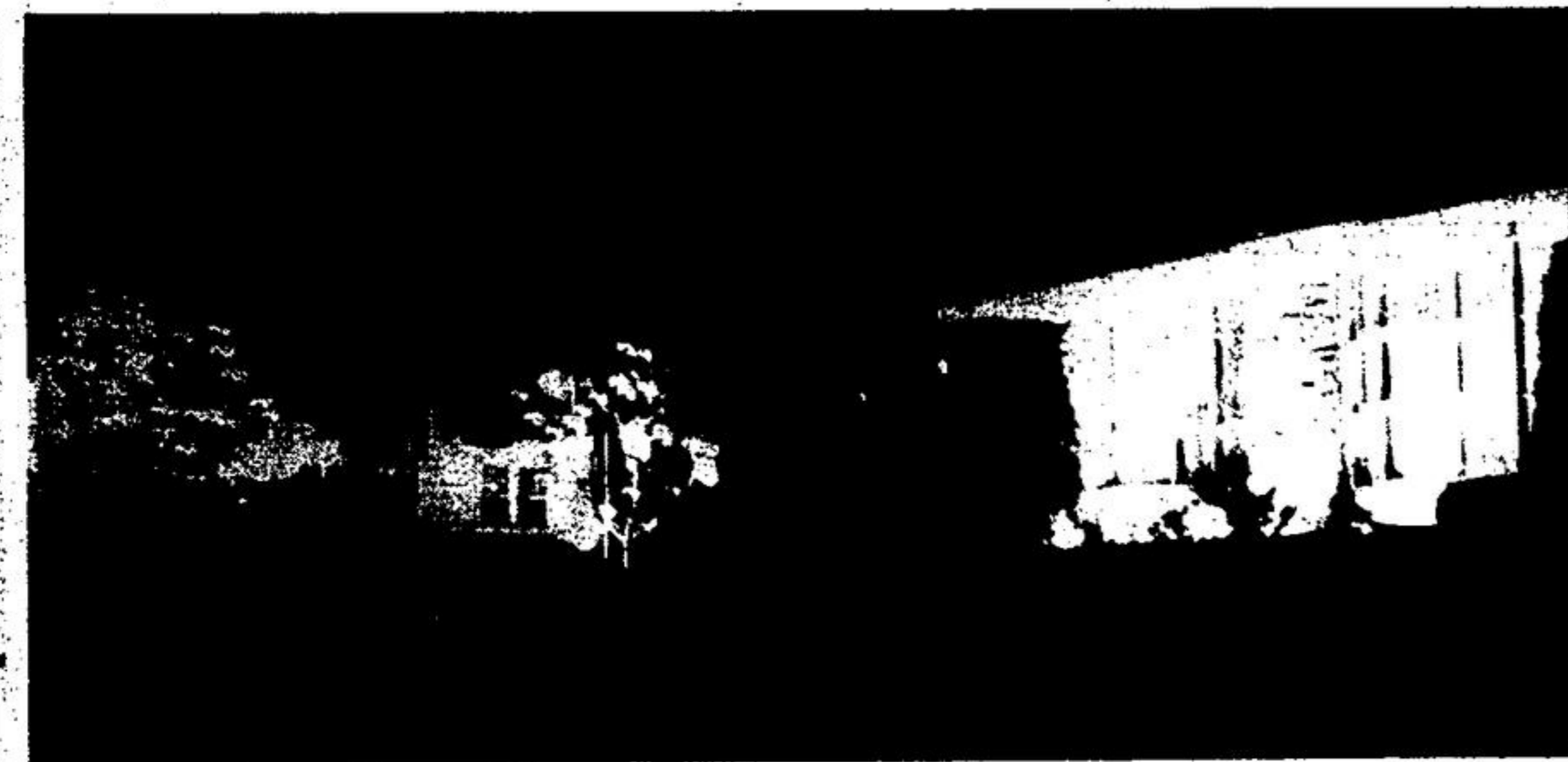

Be sure and buy only heavy duty strings of lights for outside lighting. Rain or snow can cause short circuits in lights, not specifically made for outside use. Test them as soon as you get home to be sure they are in good operating condition. You won't be able to take them back to the store next December.

North Halton O.P.P. Report for the Week

During the week of Dec. 17 to Dec. 23 inclusive, personnel of North Halton Detachment Ontario Provincial Police, worked a total of 963 3/4 hours and patrolled 7,789 miles on area highways. As a result of patrol 51 charges were preferred, 46 traffic warnings were issued and 22 vehicles were safety checked.

There were 6 property damage accidents investigated and 2 personal injury accidents, resulting in 4 persons being injured and property damage totaling \$3,275. Causes of accidents were: inattentive driving, driver lost control, on wrong side of road, passing in intersection, speed too fast for road or traffic conditions (icy roads). There were 4 charges laid as a result of these accidents. There were 34 convictions registered in Magistrate's Court.

There were 48 general occurrences reported during this period, including 1 break enter and theft investigation; theft of a pig in Nassagaweya Twp.; 1 person charged with fraud; 1 person charged with public mischief; 1 person charged with assault; theft from parked auto; 1 liquor investigation resulting in 1 person being charged under the Liquor Control Act; 2 premises found

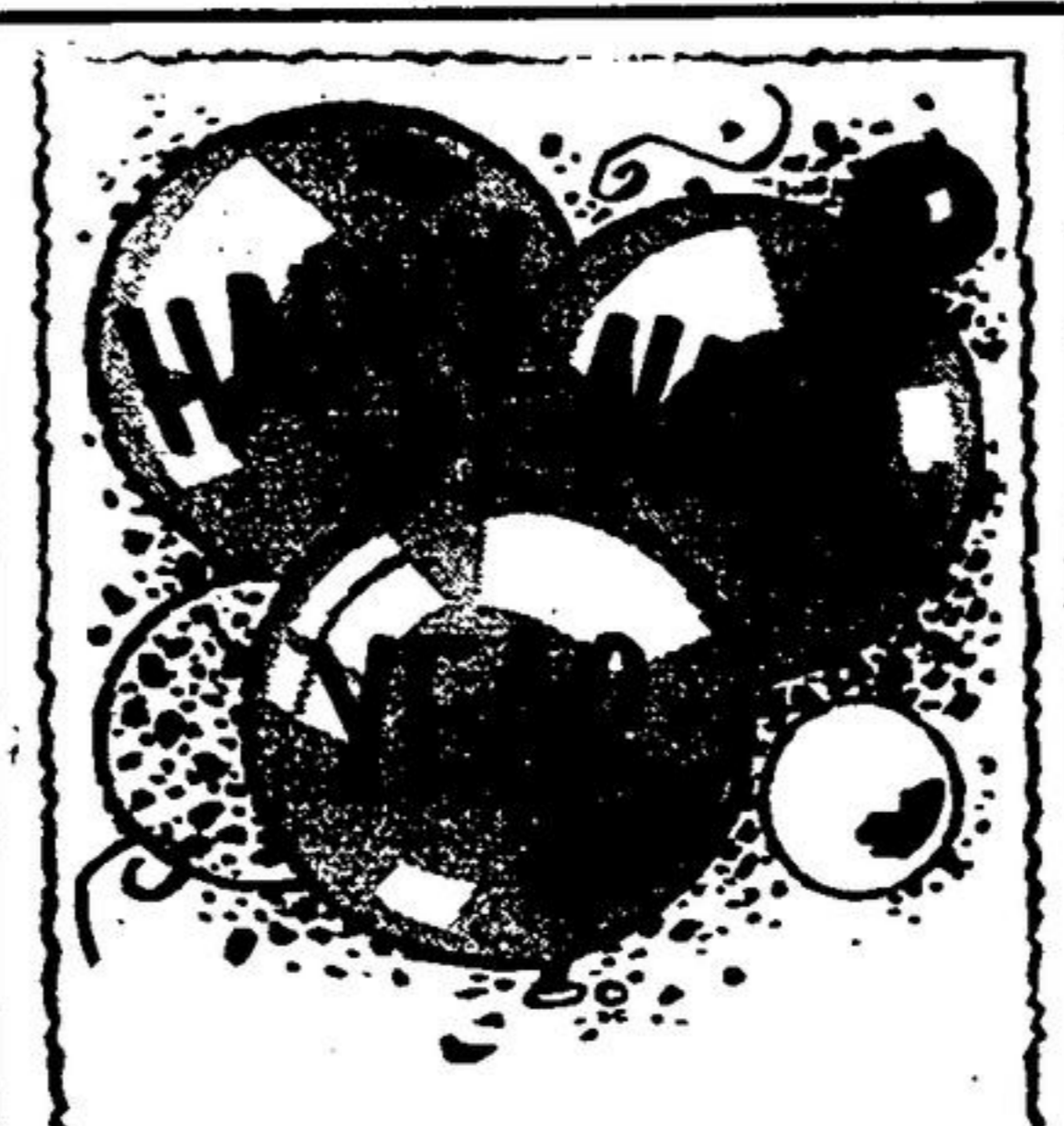

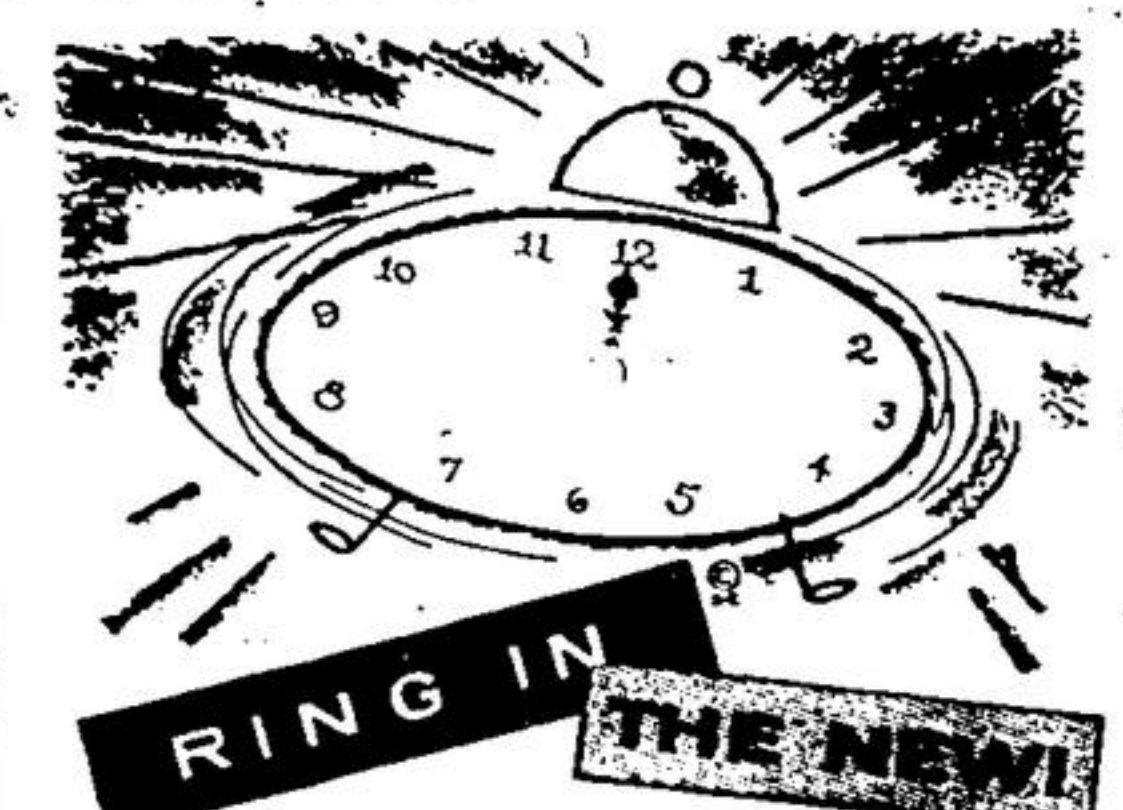
