THE HOUSE OF Commens is proceeding with the Broadcas!ing Act and it is not likely to be senf to the Senate until sometime in January 1968.

THE MINISTER of Justice has introduced in the House of Commons an Omnibus Bill dealing with the Criminal Code which will cover many matters such as breathalyser tests; abortion; lotteries; and firearms. This is a very long Bill, 75 pages in length, and has become a public document at this time in order that its many different clauses and provisions may be studied for at least a menth before the Government proceeds with them in the House of Commons.


