Celebrates 3rd Anniversary

Canadian Motor Industries Holdings Limited celebrated the third anniversary of its founding with an all-time record month in March. President Narumani Yano reported today that the company had sold 377 Toyota and Isuzu automobiles, an increase of more than 287 per cent of the wholesale sales last March.

Dynamic, 37-year old Yano is predicting a big year for Japanese cars as sales in the first quarter continue to exceed the company's estimates. He said that orders in hand would have yielded well over 600 unit sales for the month if enough product had been available. The company has been suffering from a supply problem since last September because of the shortage of shipping on Pacific routes. He added that the problems have now been overcome and the company is expecting its largest shipments since it commenced operations.

Japanese imports are gaining because of the aggressive attitude being adopted by Japanese factories and distribution organizations and because Japanese manufacturers are building cars which have demonstrated suitability in terms of endurance, style, performance and comfort for the North American market. He also cited the economic necessity for Japan to increase its North American exports in an effort to balance its trade gap with the dollar trading block.
