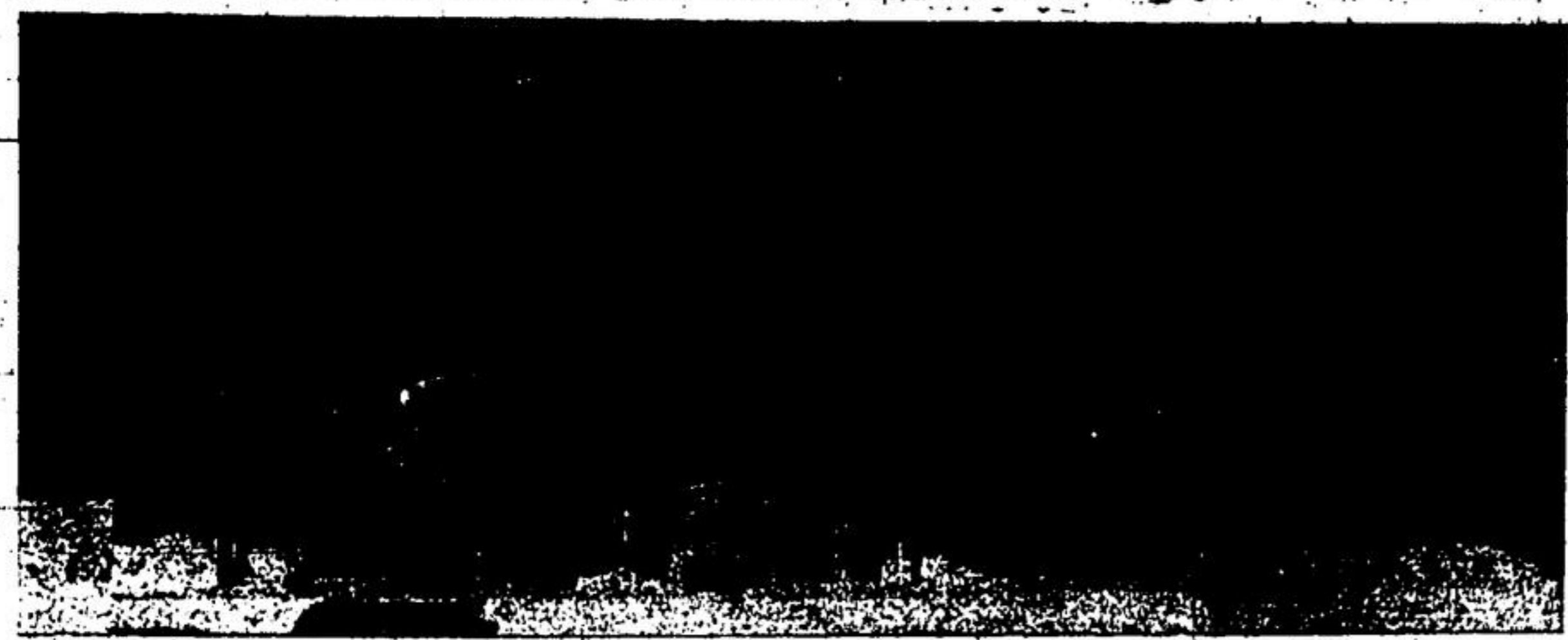


**Better Roads Forecast

**Society Publishes Bible
In 242 Different Languages**

Sunday, May 5, is Bible Society Sunday in Canada. This marks the 164th anniversary of the British and Foreign Bible Society which was founded in 1804. At this time the scriptures were being translated into only 72 different languages. Today, the Bible Society is translating the whole Bible into 242 different languages and at least one book into 1326 languages. Last year the scriptures appeared in a new language every 8 days.

It is because of the Bible Society's basic conviction that the Bible has a message for the 20th century and that God uses this book to accomplish great things, that it continues its traditional task of providing it for the missionaries, the churches and the peoples of the world. The work is carried on in over 150 countries and in Asia, Africa and Latin America, 95% of all scripture distribution is linked with the work of the Bible Society.

In vast areas of this world, the Bible Society must provide the scriptures at a fraction of their cost and in many cases — free of charge. The world budget of the 35 Bible Societies of the world in the fellowship of the United Bible Societies is \$7,500,000 for 1968. This is the to pay the loss sustained minimum that is required to cover the cost of translation and through distributing scriptures below cost and free of charge. The Canadian Bible Society's share of the required sum is \$800,000.

Canadian Bible Society canvassers will be calling at local homes during the week of May 6th.

The Canadian National Institute for the Blind serves 26,049 blind persons.

**Lyons Gets Top \$600
At Rockwood Calf Sale**

Holstein buyers paid a strong average price of \$260 for 62 lots at the recently held annual Rockwood calf sale at Georgetown sales arena, Georgetown.

Agro Bros. Hamilton paid high sale price of \$600 for a late July calf consigned by Clark L. Lyons of Norval. The heifer, Agro Acres Supreme Dewdrop, was sired by Thames Crest Sovereign Supreme.

Second high sale price of \$560 was paid by Roger Harrop Milton, for a November calf contributed by Stu Hutchins, Paris. The heifer, Pickland Emperor Susan, was sired by Downlane Reflection Emperor.

R. Dale Jones from Indiana, who took a total of 24 calves, paid third high price of \$510 for an October daughter of Rose Citation R and out of a daughter of Dividend Clipper. Consignor was Opache Farms Brampton.

In addition to the 24 head taken by Jones for export to the United States, other calves were sold for export to Italy and England.

Sale managers were Rockwood International, Georgetown.
