**Approve 12-Suite Apartment Project**

Adopting the recommendation of the Planning Board council on Monday approved a twelve suite apartment on Water St.

The twelve suite apartment building proposed by Odorico Construction, will have fourteen underground parking spaces, plus three others in the side of the hill.

Again following the Planning Board's suggestion council turned down an application from Oriole Block to construct a four suite duplex on Morris Street.

Cr. Roy Ballentine explained that Morris Street is only a ten foot wide road running off Chapel Street, north west of the firehall. Insufficient land and road-width was given as the reason for refusal.

**Hydro Plans Debenture Issue For \$125,000**

A by-law to borrow \$125,000 on debenture for the hydro, brought instant criticism from Cr. Jim Young at council Monday night.

"It's the first time I've heard of this" he began. "We don't even know what they intend to do. It says to buy water heaters and improve street lighting, but it seems odd to saddle the taxpayers with an \$125,000 debenture to buy water heaters then sell them back to them."

He then asked if anyone knew how they intended to improve street lighting. The mayor pointed out that the water heaters would be purchased as they were needed. He also claimed it was the first time the hydro had borrowed money, but the rapid expansion of the town forced it.

Only Cr. Young opposed the by-law.
