**Mrs. R. McNamara Descendant Of Four Pioneer Families**

Mrs. Richard McNamara, who died on July 3 in her 91st year, was the descendant of four of the pioneer families of Esqueping Township — Thompson, Cooke, Standish and Joyce.

Following a Toronto funeral service, she was buried beside her husband in the family plot in Greenwood Cemetery here. The former Wilhelmina Georgina Thompson was born January 21, 1878 on the farm of her grandfather Major George Thompson, which comprised of the east half of Lots 16 and 17, Concession 2, Esqueping. Georgetown has now nearly equalled the farm, but the red brick house in which she was born can still be seen on the north side of Number 15 street, just east of Stewarttown. The house is known to have been built prior to 1850 and replaced the original log house on the site.

Major Thompson purchased this farm in 1835. He had emigrated to Quebec from County Leitrim, and few children. They proceeded to Esqueping Township where brothers of Major and Mrs. Thompson had already settled. Among Mrs. Thompson's brothers was Thomas Cooke who around 1830 left Stewarttown and settled in the north-east corner of Tecumseh Township, Simcoe County, and whose name is commemorated by the present village of Cookstown.

Major Thompson was commissioned as a captain in the 5th Gens Militia in 1826 and was called into active service during the Rebellion of 1837. His ceremonial sword is still in the hands of Mr. Franklin Thompson of Milton. Meanwhile his wife remained at home with her family, which then numbered eight children, and according to family tradition, had a most unpleasant encounter with a bear at her well.

Major Thompson was for many years a J.P. for the Home District. He died in 1881. Mrs. McNamara's father, George Christopher Thompson, was born in Esqueping Township in 1831. Her mother, Georgina Elizabeth Standish, was also born in the township. She was the daughter of Thomas Standish and Rachel Joyce. Her paternal grandfather, Joseph Standish, a native of Queen's County Ireland, had settled on Lot 13, Concession 7, Esqueping in 1819. The first meeting of Esqueping residents was held at his house on January 1, 1821.
