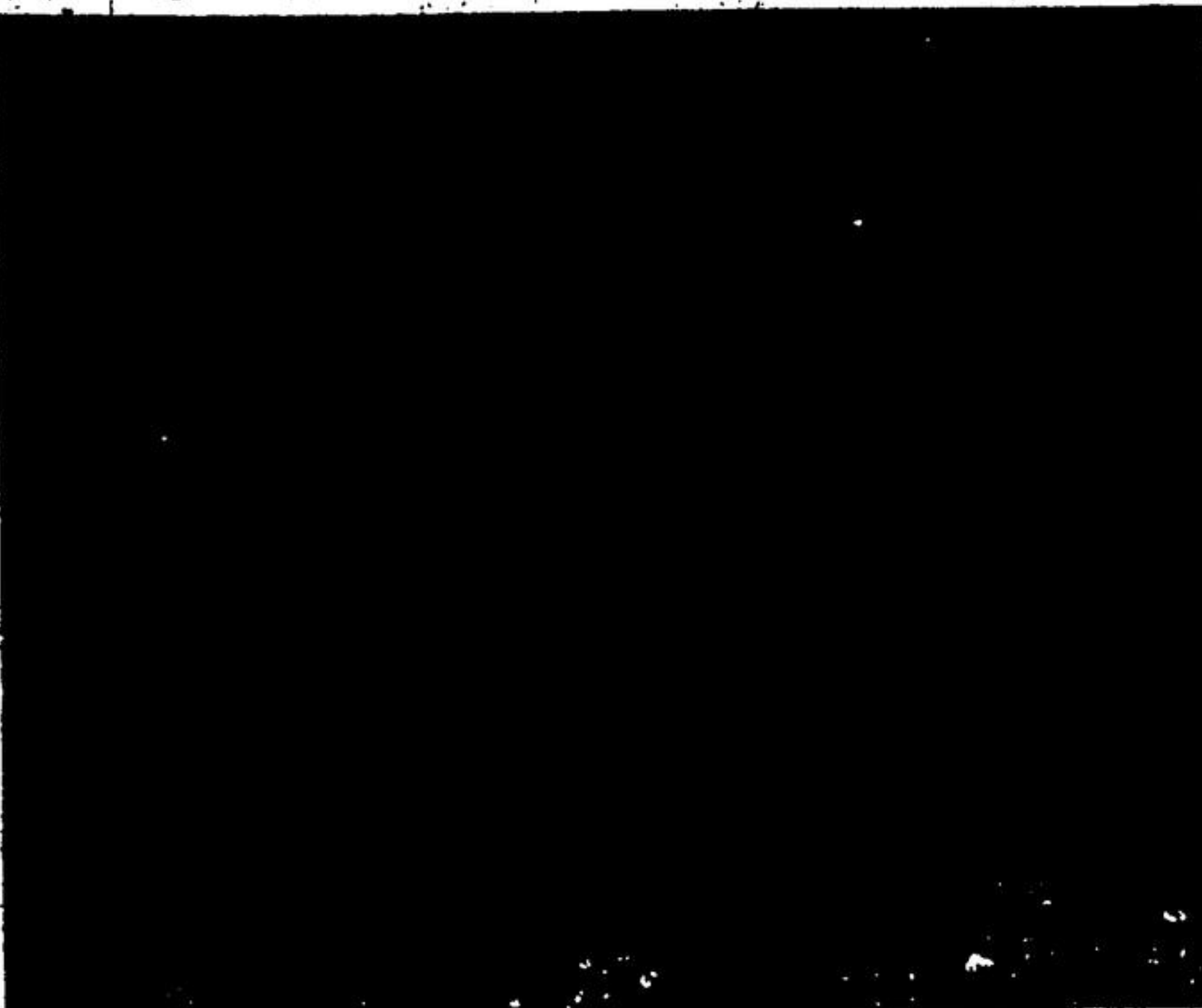


HEIFERS HEAD FOR DOMINICA

Halton Beef Producers Are High in Competition

Competitors from Halton County placed high in the beef classes at the CNE. In the Angus section J.T. Willmott and Son, Milton, were runner-up for the Premier Exhibitor to E.P. Taylor's Winfield Farms, coming within 3 points of winning the coveted award. They placed 3rd for the Premier Breeder. Willmott's entries won the Cow and Calf, 2 year old Heifer, and Yearling Bull Classes. They were 2nd in the age bull to the grand champion, and 3rd on Breeders Herd. At the Central Canadian Exhibition, Ottawa, the Willmott cattle were runner-up to Winfield Farms, for both Breeder and Exhibitor Banners, winning two firsts, having the first prize Breeder Herd, and 1st reserve junior champion bull. The Shorthorn Classes were dominated by the entries of S.G. Bennett, Georgetown, and Redford Gardhouse, Milton. In the Hereford Section James J. McCarthy & Son Georgetown, won the Yearling Bull Class and placed 3rd in the Registered Steer Class, and in this class the steer is judged both on the hoof and as a carcass. The top two places in the class were won by Angus.
