Investigation is continuing today into what police describe as the murder-suicide of Janette and Ronald Beers, last Wednes-

Chinguacousy police chiel Ken Sider confirmed that an inquest will be held into the double fatality. He said no date for the inquest has been set.

The fatal shootings occurred late Wednesday evening on the Second line West, north of Highway 7. There is some doubt yet as to whether one of the victims -the girl-may not have been shet at the intersection of Highway 10 and Highway 7 by-pass.

It was at the intersection that Chinguacousy constable John Bottomley, parked in a cruiser nearby, heard a girl scream The car took off at a high rate of speed with the officer in pur-


