3 Collisions, \$1900 In Damage to Autos

Three collisions on Georgetown streets resulted in over \$1,900 in property damage during the past week.

A three car smash on Sinclair near Duncan Drive Saturday did a total of \$285 to vehicles driven by Gerald McHale of 39 Sargent Road, Brian Preston of Glen Williams, and Carl Tomlin of 48 McIntyre Crescent. Police said the McHale car collided with the back end of Preston's stopped car knocking it into Tomlin's car.

Later the same day, a car driven by Samuel Archibald of Brampton hit the back end of a car driven by Joseph Goudie, 52 Edith Street, at the corner of King Street and Mountainview Road bumping it across Mountainview into a stone wall.

An accident in the high school parking lot last Thursday did \$76 to a car driven by John Reaume, 8 Halo Drive and \$200 to a parked car owned by David Frazer of Bramalea.

Police said Reaume was attempting to park when the car skidded into the Frazer vehicle. The parking lot was icy at the time of the accident, approximately 8:40 p.m.

Broken Leg, Lacerations In Three Car Collision

A Norval area man is in Georgetown District Memorial Hospital recovering from severe head and neck lacerations and a broken left leg suffered Monday morning in a three car accident on Highway 7 just east of Georgetown.

Philip Paulin, of R.R. 2, Norval was injured when a car driven by Don Reed of Hillsburgh went out of control while passing a car driven by Gilbert Talbot of King Street, Georgetown and went into a skid.

North Halton OPP said the front of Reed's car struck Paulin's car which was travelling in the opposite direction, and the rear end of Reed's car slammed into Talbot's car.

Reed and Talbot escaped injury.

Damage was estimated at \$750 to Reed's car, \$750 to Paulin's car, and \$50 to Talbot's car.

The accident happened at 8:20 a.m.
