

The Dep- named to the post. artment of Public Works has optioned another 40 acres of the site for correctional services.

200 INMATES

The department plans to build the reformatory wing to house 200 inmates now serving sentences in Mimico Reformatory A training centre for another 200 inmates and a regional detention centre to replace exist. ing century-old county juils in both Halton and Peel are to be constructed later.

Plans call for the Mimico institution to be transformed into enlarged clinics for sexual offenders, drug addicts and alcoholics, many of whom now are at Millbrook Reformatory. The Millbrook prison will be used as a regional detention centre for the Kawartha area.

The decision to build the Ma plehurst correctional complex came after auccessive grand jury reports branded Halton County Juli as outmoded and inadequate to incarcerate pri-

Milton council recently voted to accept the department's latest offer of grants towards the cost of extending town services such as water and sewer lines to the proposed reformatory.

REGIONAL CENTRE

The new Maplehurst prison and correction centre will serve the Halton and Peel region. The county jails in both Halton and Peel counties have been heav

The last investigation into the century old Halton jail came after four prisoners, escaped in September.
