Alcohol Involved in Many Fatal Accidents

Nearly one out of every ten motor vehicle deaths last year occurred during the month of December. Over half of the December fatalities involved drinking drivers, and one out of four December traffic accidents involving drinking pedestrians. During the last six hours of Christmas Eve the hourly rate of fatal accidents was about 5 times greater than for the remainder of the holiday.

While inclement weather and increased downtown traffic can bear a portion of the blame, alcohol with its impairment of critical judgment and ability must be a major contributor in three out of four fatal Christmas accidents involving speed-excessive for existing conditions or visibility.

If you take an occasional drink, and if you drink a little more than usual during the December holidays, the grim statistics of DANGEROUS DECEMBER should spell out a clear warning. A warning that the odds favouring a fatal holiday accident on the highway or on the crosswalk rise in proportion to the number of drinks you have had.

To take at least some of the danger out of December you should keep your holiday drinking at a realistic minimum. Or better yet, avoid it completely. The true spirit of Christmas doesn't come in a bottle.

HARDER TO STOP

Now that the winter season has arrived the Provincial Department of Transport urges, when on foot in traffic be extra alert. Remember — it's harder for drivers to slow down or stop when roads are slippery.
