Births Increase by Seventy at Hospital

Over 500 more patients were admitted to Georgetown & District Memorial Hospital in 1968 than the previous year according to figures just released.
The 1968 admissions total 2,337 compared to 1,805 the previous year.
There were also more births, 318 in 1968 than in 1967 when 248 newborn were listed.
Also vastly increased are the number of emergency visits, 3,527 compared to 2,234 two years ago.

ADOPTIONS UP CAS ANNOUNCES

Adoptions in the county last year have increased over the number in 1967, the Halton County Children's Aid Society announced this week.
Eighty-five children from the county's own ward and 58 from other societies were placed on adoption during the period January to December, 1968, said Dr. Gordon Askwith, society director.
In comparison, 72 from the county and 53 from outside the county were placed on adoption in 1967.
