Describes Hudson Bay Topography to Naturalists

The Georgetown & District Naturalists' Club held their February meeting in the basement of the First Baptist Church at which time two York University students told of their part in a geo-botanical survey conducted in Polar Bear National Park during last summer.

John Richardson was interested in the geological aspects of the north. His work was to determine the age of the land. This was achieved by the radiocarbon dating of fossils.

He said the land around Hudson and James Bay is a very young area, possibly the youngest in North America. He explained how the weight of the glacier in centuries gone had compressed the land and now that the ice is melted the land is rebounding. It is a very low marshy area with numerous fishless lakes and some ridges.

Bill Phillips did research on plants and trees. The trees — black spruce, larch dwarf willow — are found in the valley along the rivers. There is a constant wind of 15 m.p.h. which greatly effects the tree growth. One picture showed trees growing in the protection of a ridge with their lower branches green and healthy. The branches above the ridge were killed by the wind. The oldest tree sample taken was dated 1834.

He told of the reindeer moss and lichen and said that two hundred species of flowers are all very small — bloom in a three week period in the summer. The average temperature from June to August last year was forty degrees.

Mrs. A.J. Dewdney thanked the students for their informative talk which was made more interesting by slides, maps and samples of their work.

The results of the club's photo contest, as well as nature films will be shown at the March meeting on Tuesday, March 18. Anyone interested is welcome to attend.
